Dear Mrs. Fletcher:

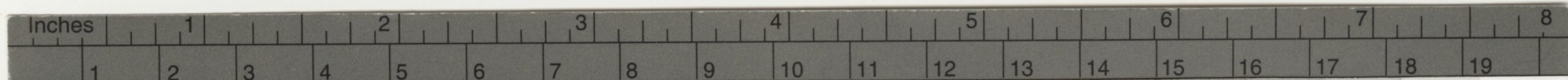
As Librarian of Bath Community Library I would like to ask you if you would donate us some of the books you have written.
