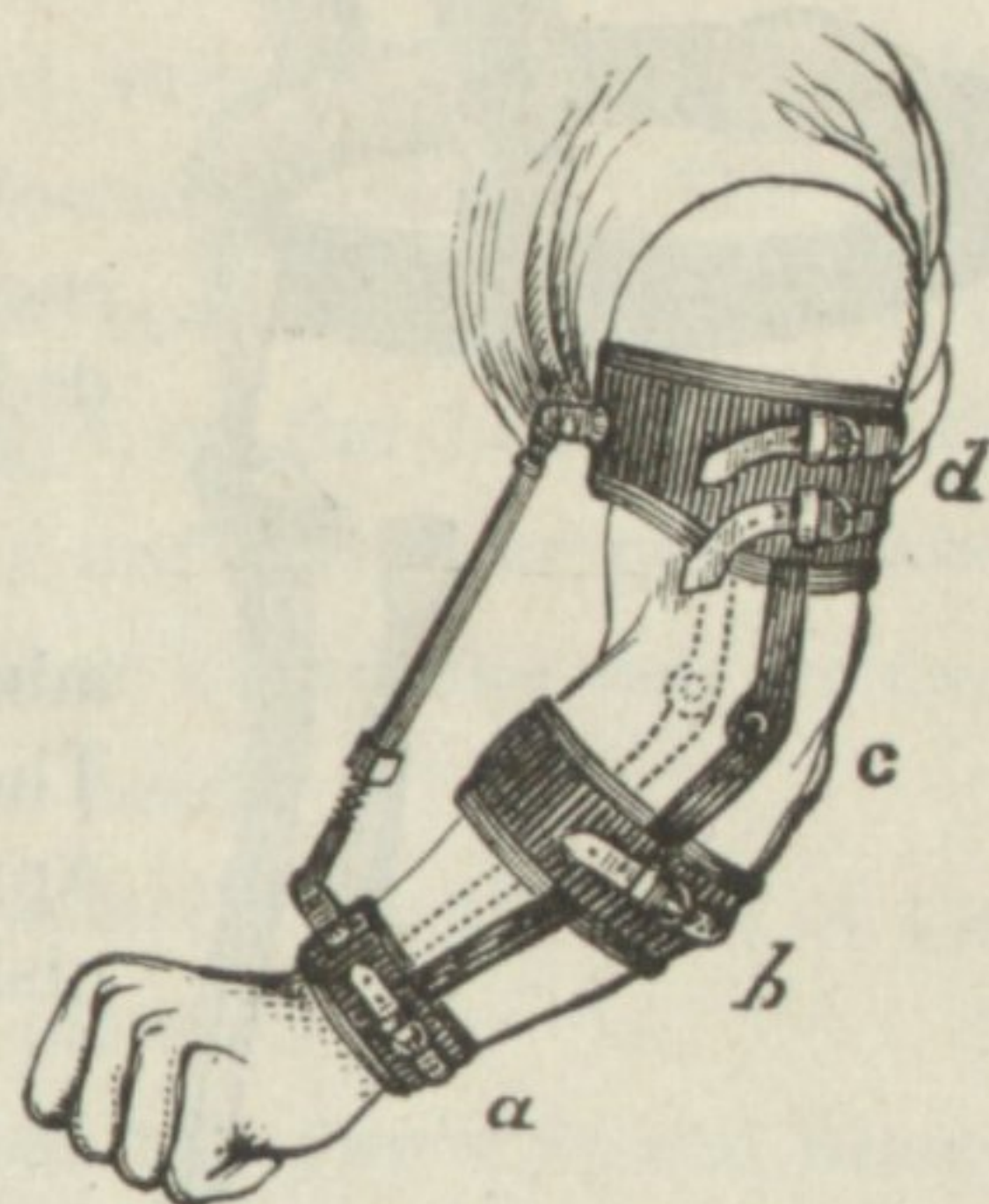


ORTHOPÆDIC APPARATUS.

2369 * Apparatus for False Anchylosis of the Elbow-Joint.

The apparatus here represented is for the gradual extension of contracted muscles. By persistent and daily passive and active exercise a flexible and useful joint may be restored. It may also be used for forcible breaking up of false anchylosis, if the surgeon prefers this to gradual extension. It forms also a safeguard against malposition, for should it be deemed impossible to effect a cure, the arm may be fixed in such a position to ankylose as shall give it the greatest usefulness.



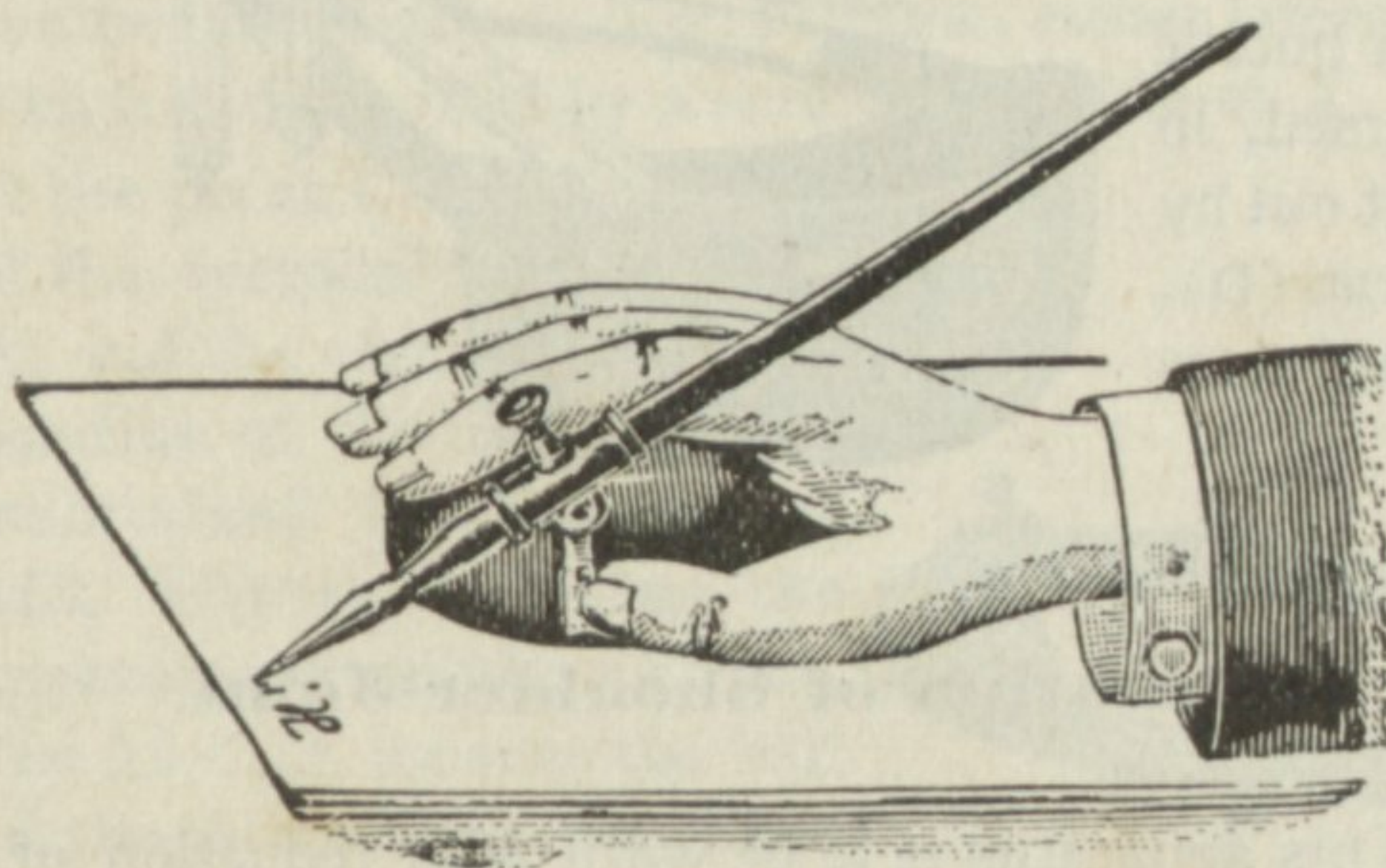

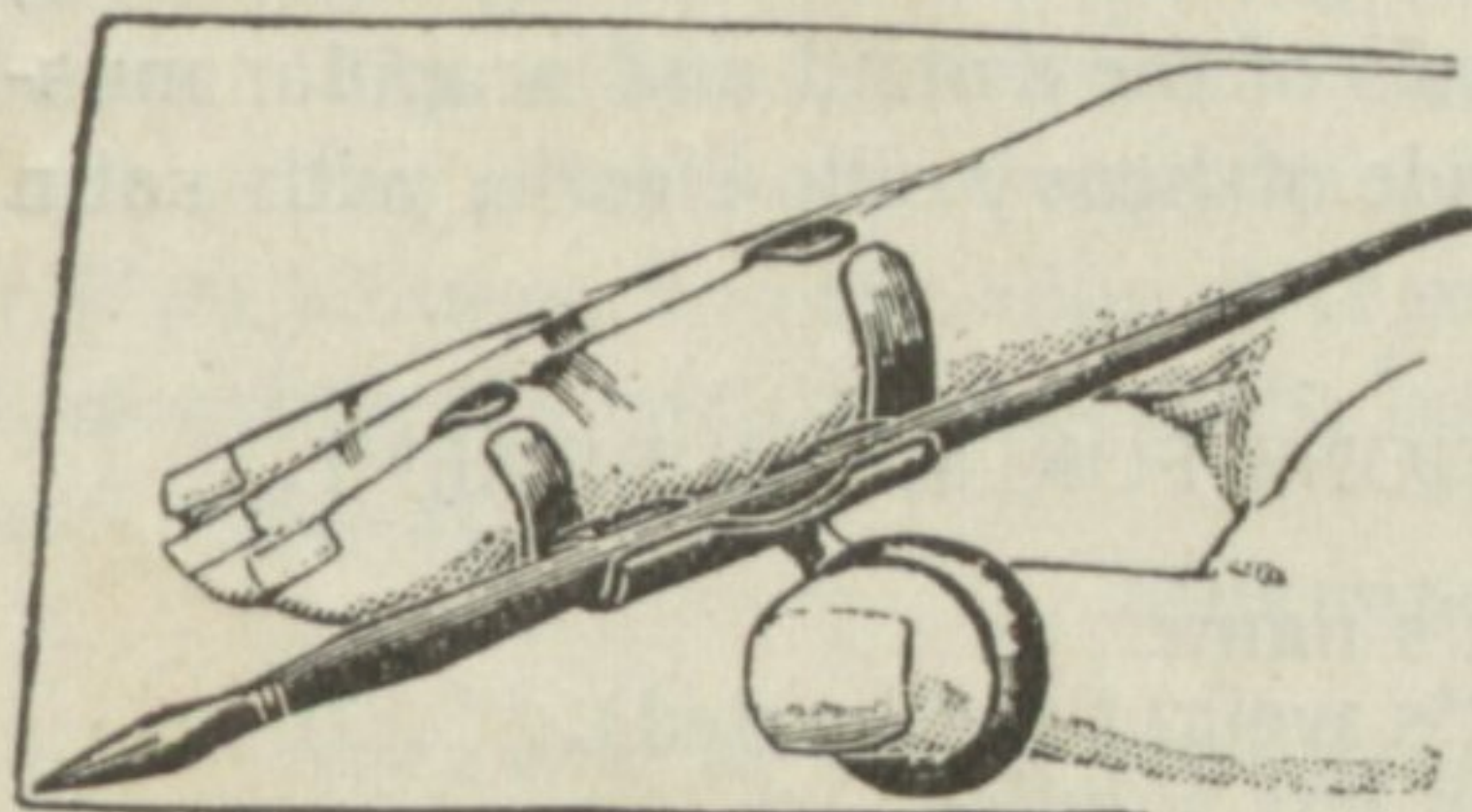
