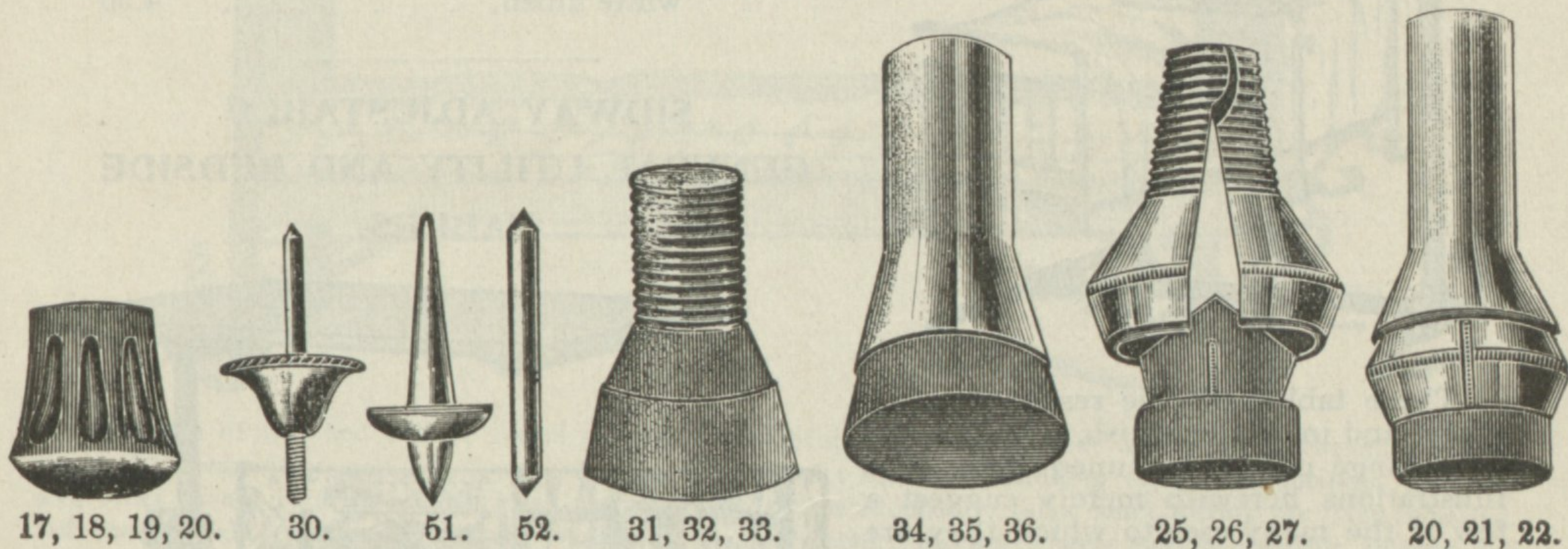

RUBBERS, SOCKETS AND SPURS FOR CRUTCHES.

17, 18, 19, 20, 21. Rubber Bottoms to be slipped over wooden end of crutch, of $\frac{3}{8}$, $\frac{3}{4}$, $\frac{7}{8}$, 1 and $1\frac{1}{8}$ inch diameter respectively; applicable to crutches 3 and 4, per pair.....	\$ 0.25
31, 32, 33. Rubber Bottoms to screw into sockets 34, 35, 36, three sizes, per pair.....	25, 35, 45c.
25, 26, 27. Rubber Bottoms, $1\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{7}{8}$ 11-16 inch respectively, for sockets 20, 21, 22, per pair.....	\$ 0.25
34, 35, 36. Sockets for 31, 32 and 33 rubber, per pair.....	1.00
20, 21, 22. Whittemore Sockets, for rubbers 25, 26 and 27.....	\$2.00, \$2.25, \$2.50
Diameter of sockets run the same as those of the brass extension pieces	
30. Ice Spur, adjustable so as to prevent dents in floors in a moment, per pair.....	\$.75

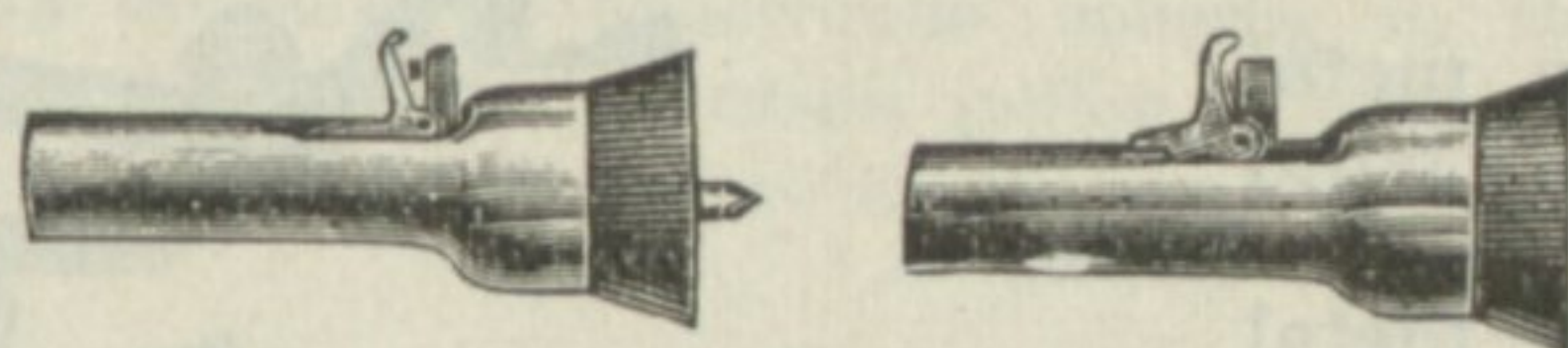


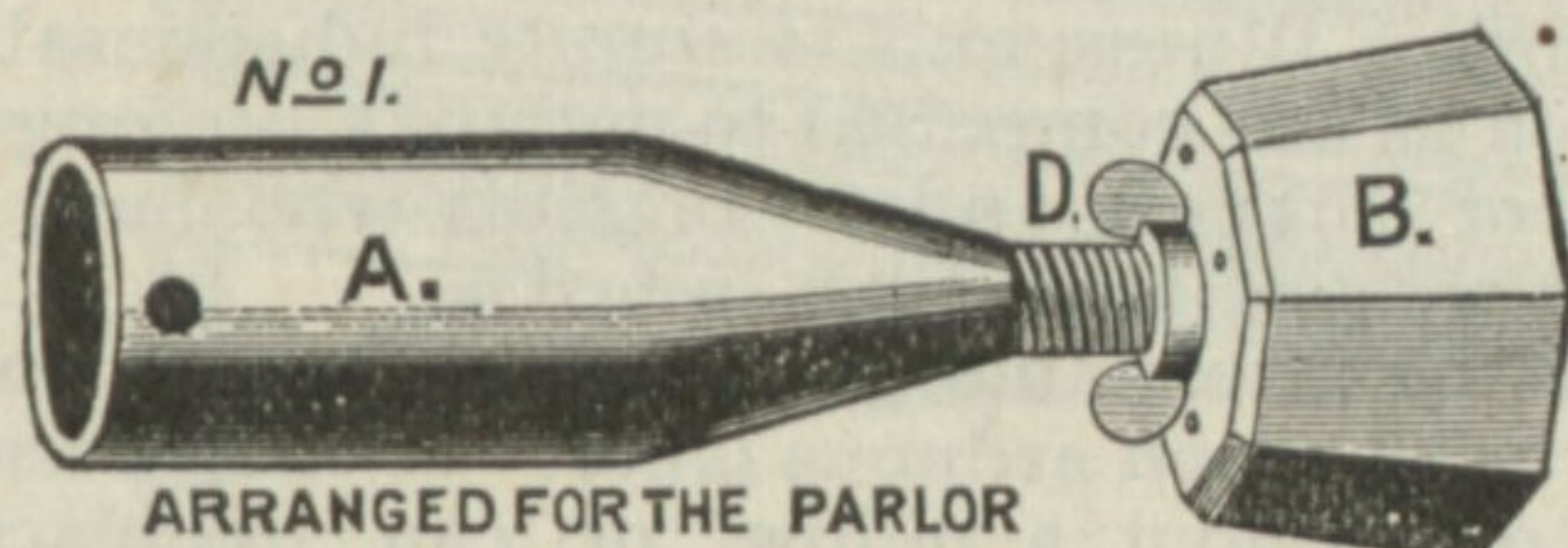

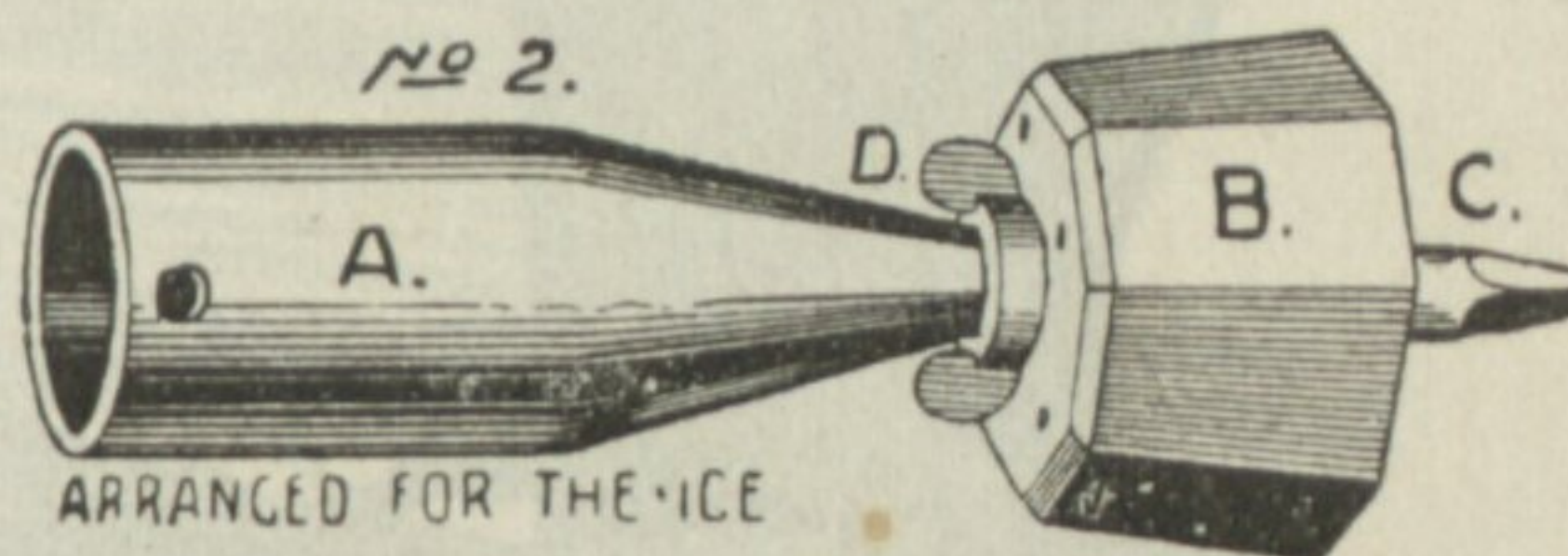
Fig. 1 illustrates the steel spur projecting through the rubber for out-door use, and Fig. 2 shows the spur withdrawn for house use. By a very simple device the change is made in a second with the foot. Made in 2 sizes. No. 61 for $\frac{3}{4}$ inch, and No. 62 for 1-inch crutches; per pair, \$1.00 and \$4.50. Extra Rubber Bottoms for No. 61 or 62, per pair.....60c.

This attachment consists of the metal Socket A, having a 4 oz. Rubber Buffer B, and Screw-plate adjusted at will, to cover for in-door use or uncover for use on the ice or slippery walks, the ice spur C, all set when necessary by the wing-nut D. Made in 5 sizes of sockets, viz: 6-8, 1, $1\frac{1}{8}$, $1\frac{1}{4}$ and $1\frac{3}{8}$ inch in diameter, external measurement with opening for wood, $\frac{5}{8}$, $\frac{3}{4}$, $1\frac{1}{8}$ and 1 3-16 inches. In ordering give circumference or diameter of crutch used at 6 inches from floor end.
