DR. LAMBERT'S MODIFICATION OF EDEBOHL'S LEG HOLDERS.

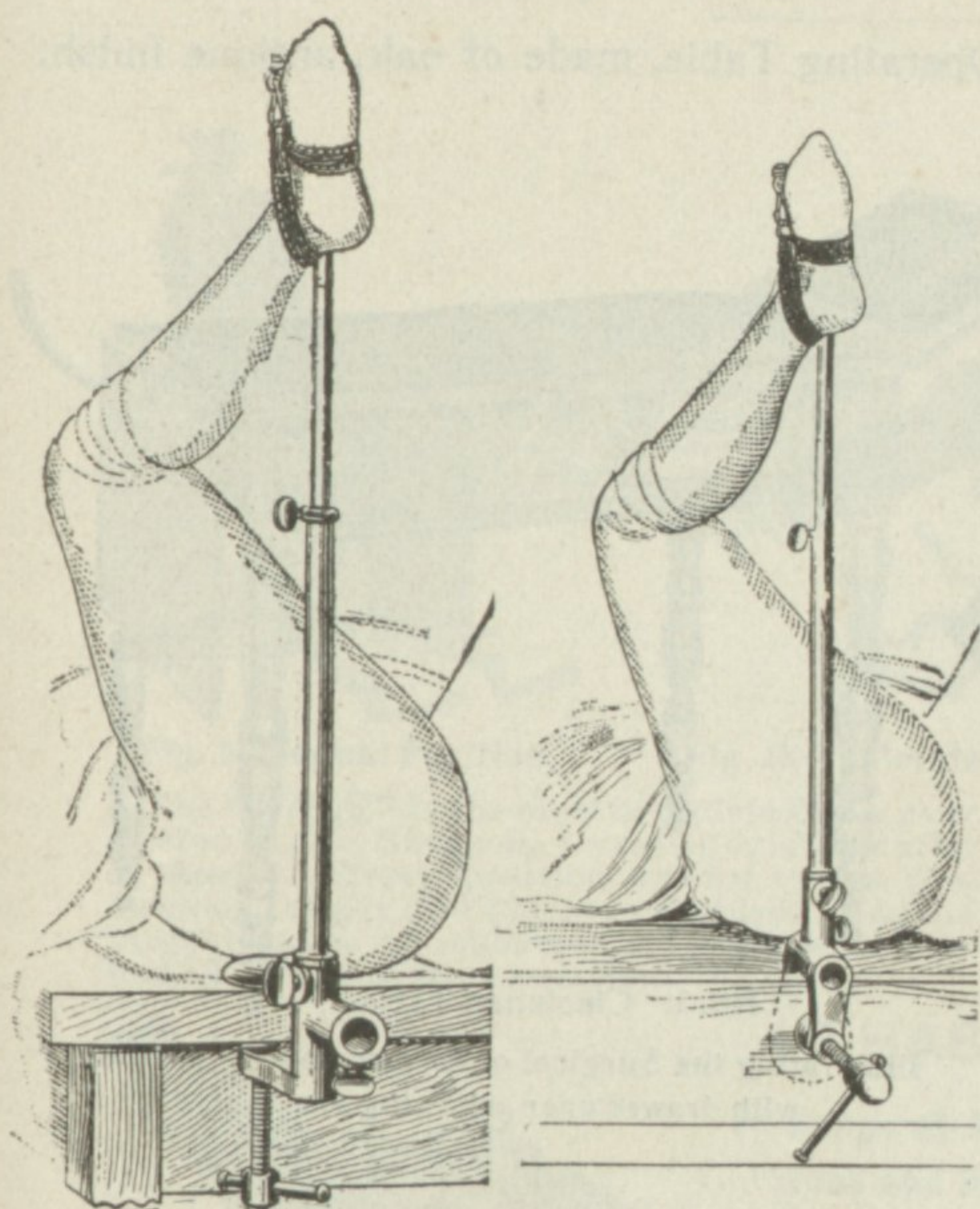

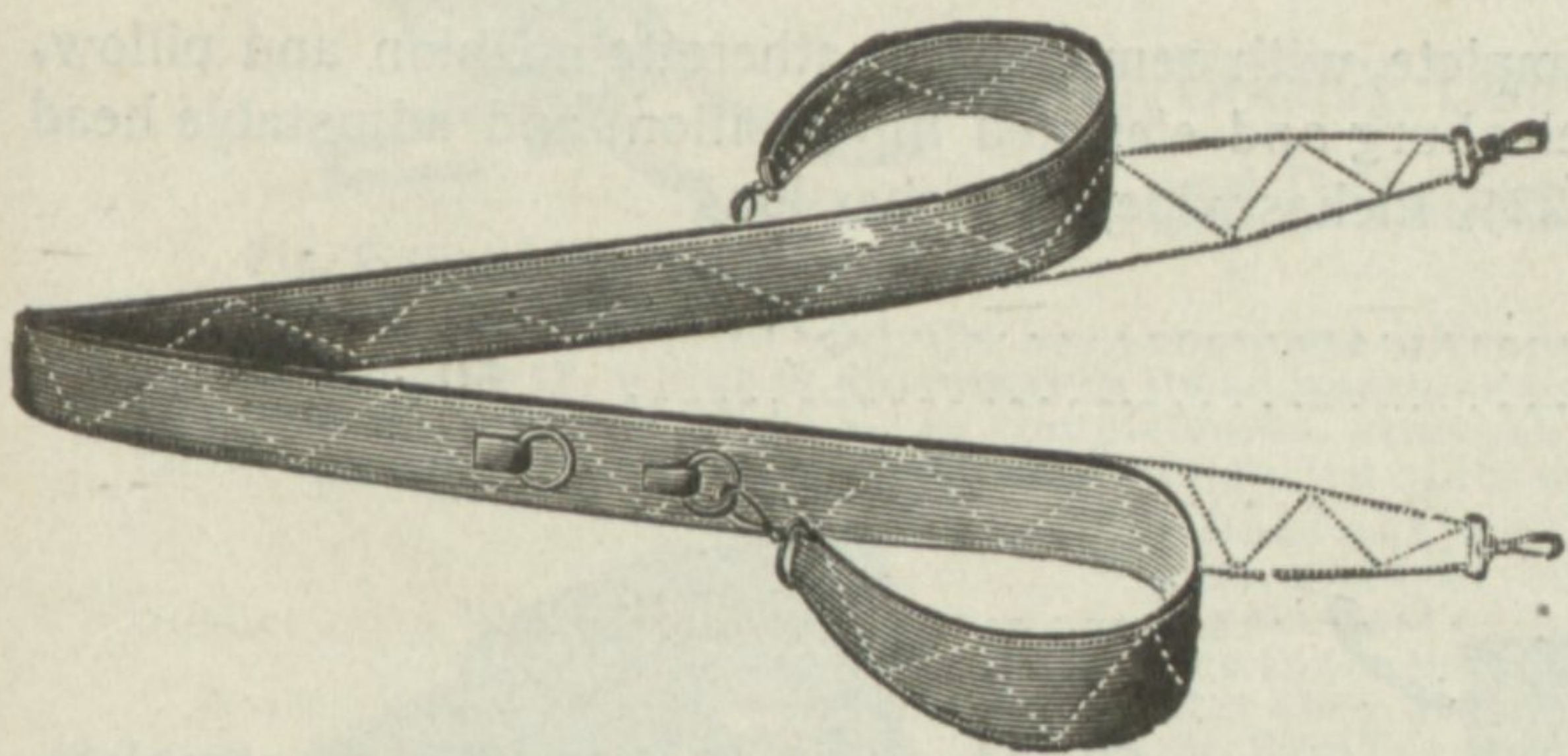

Practitioners living remote from other physicians find the various forms of Leg Holders a great convenience. My inability to attach the Edebohl's Leg Holders to the side of the bed, when I frequently wished to use them, led me to devise a clamp whereby the Holders can be fastened to the side of the bed or any board that stands on its edge.

In the illustration, Fig. A shows how the clamp may be fastened to a table. Fig. B shows how the clamp can be attached to the side of a bed.

With this improved Clamp I have found the Leg Holders of especial value when attending my obstetrical patients who reside in the country, and require instrumental delivery or perineal operations.—*Extract from the American Gynecological Journal*

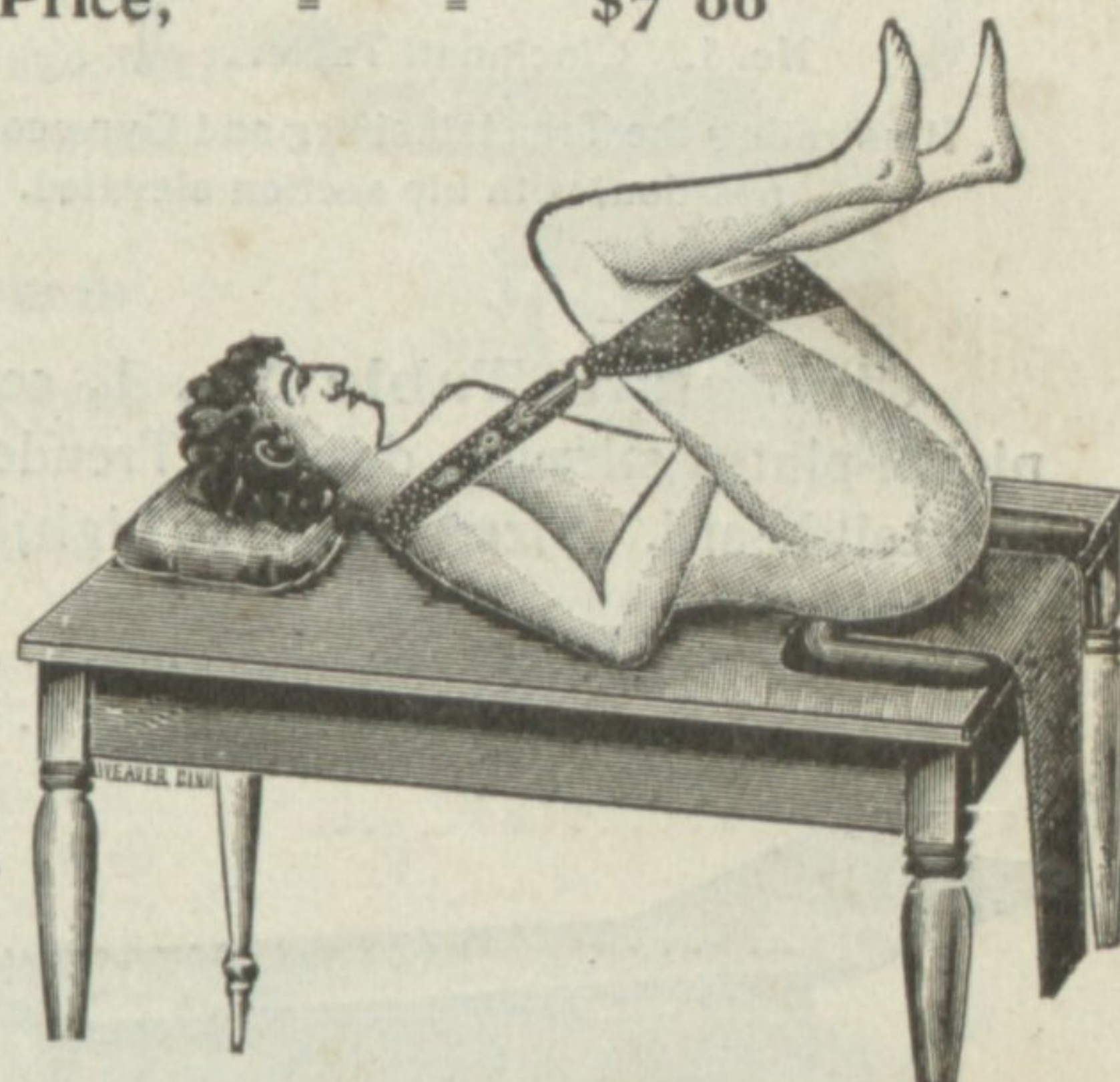
