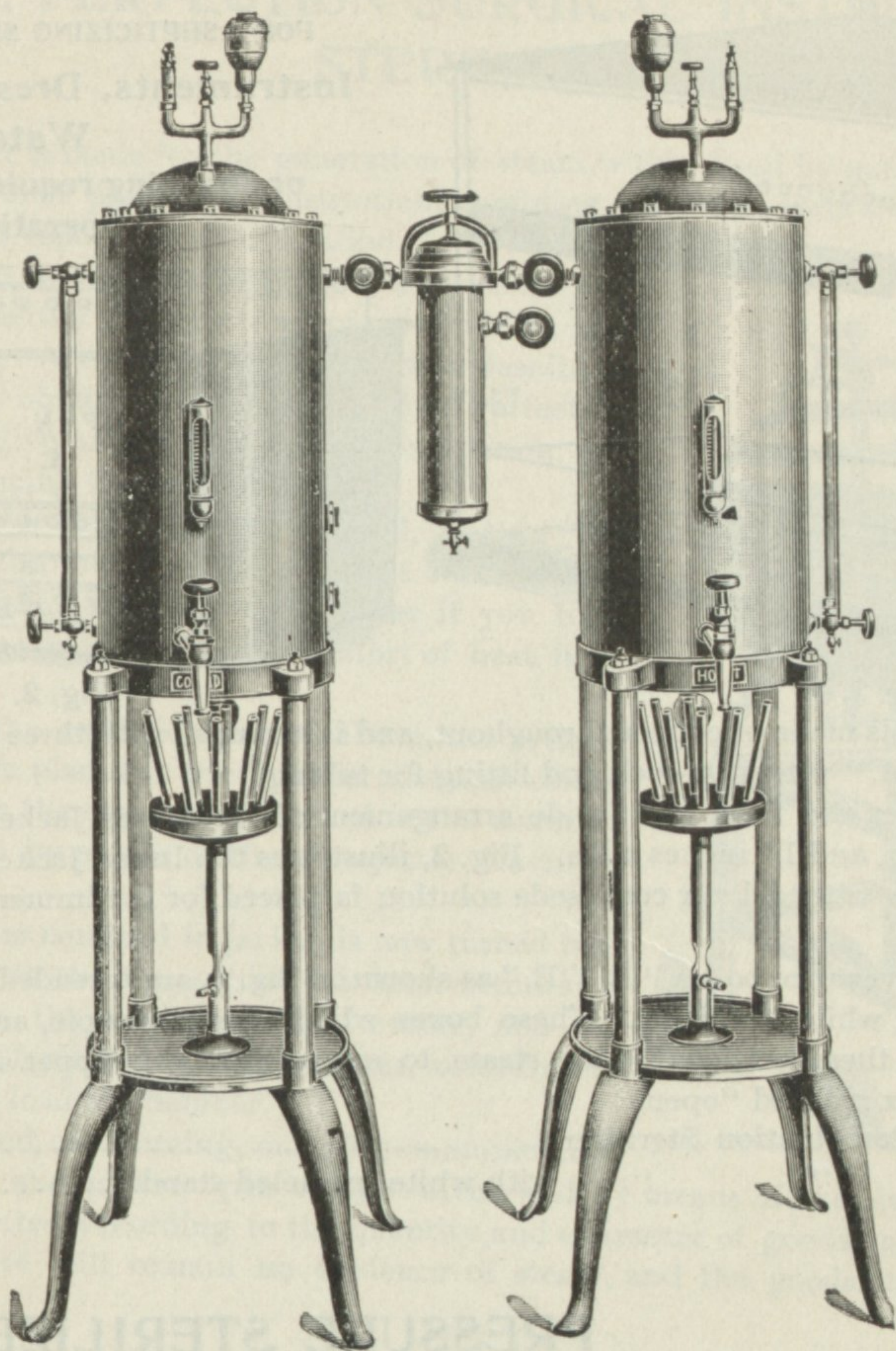


WATER STERILIZER.

AF 158 In furnishing Water Sterilizers we have had but one object in view, and that was turn out a sterilizer which in point of quality, finish and efficiency, should be superior to anything at present on the market.

The Tanks are of seamless cold drawn copper or brass, lined inside with pure tin. The casing at the cylinders *can readily be removed for the purpose of cleaning.*

On top of each tank is mounted a steam safety valve, an air cock, to allow the passage of air from the tanks when displaced by the water in filling, and an air filtering valve, which permits nothing but filtered air to enter the tanks as the water is withdrawn. Between the tanks is suspended a cleanable filter of Natural stone.

The steam heated tanks are supplied with steam, copper coils, coated with pure tin, and each cold water tank has a similar coil, through which cold water passes, cooling the water to any desired temperature after sterilizing. Other fittings include a thermometer for each tank, registering temperature and pressure; water gauge fittings, also the necessary valves for the proper control of the apparatus. "We do not supply the valves for steam and water connections, which are properly part of the installation."

We furnish these sterilizers in six different sizes, viz.: 10, 25, 50, 75 and 100 gallons to each tank, and to be heated by gas, kerosene or direct steam connection.
