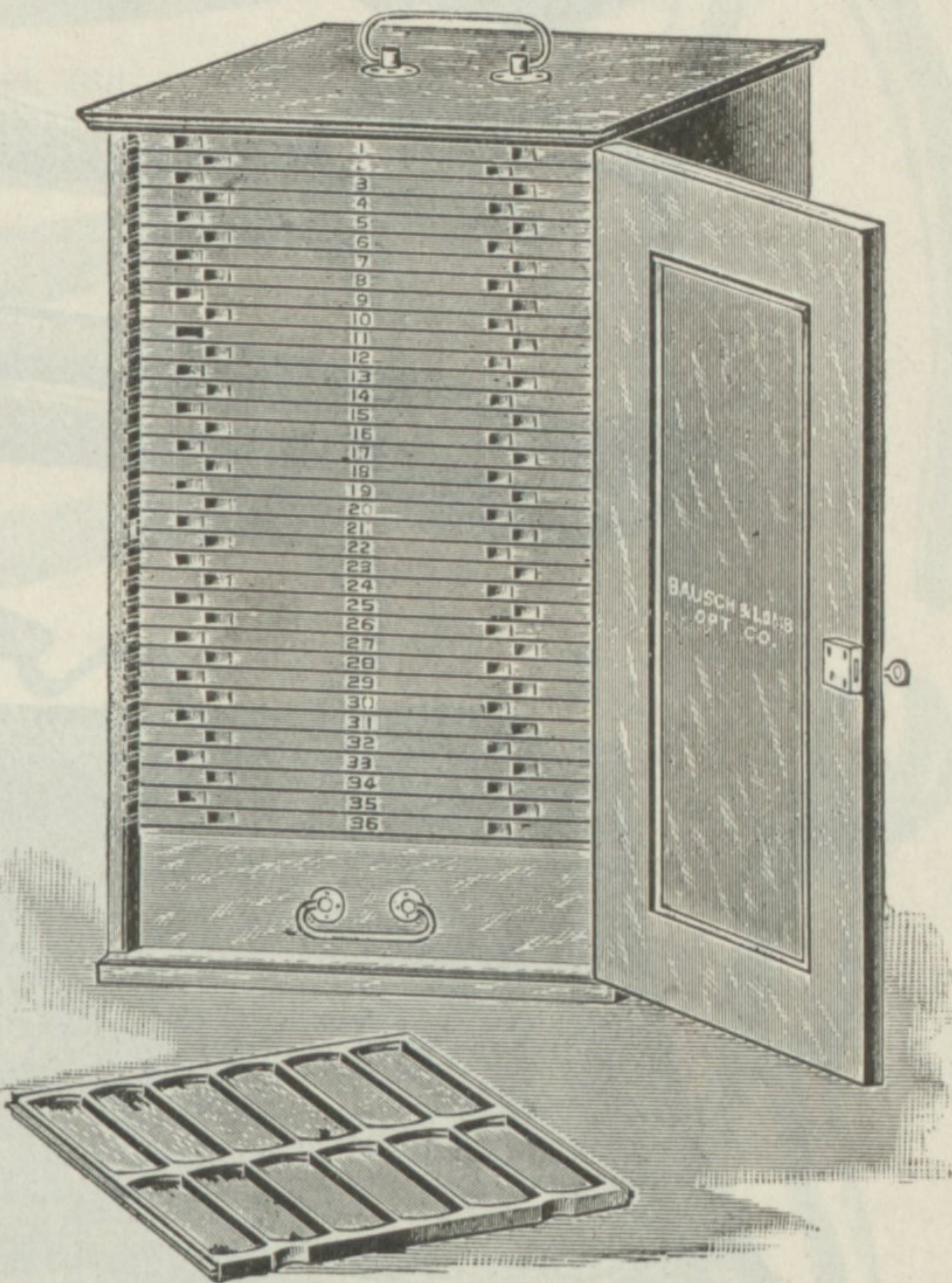

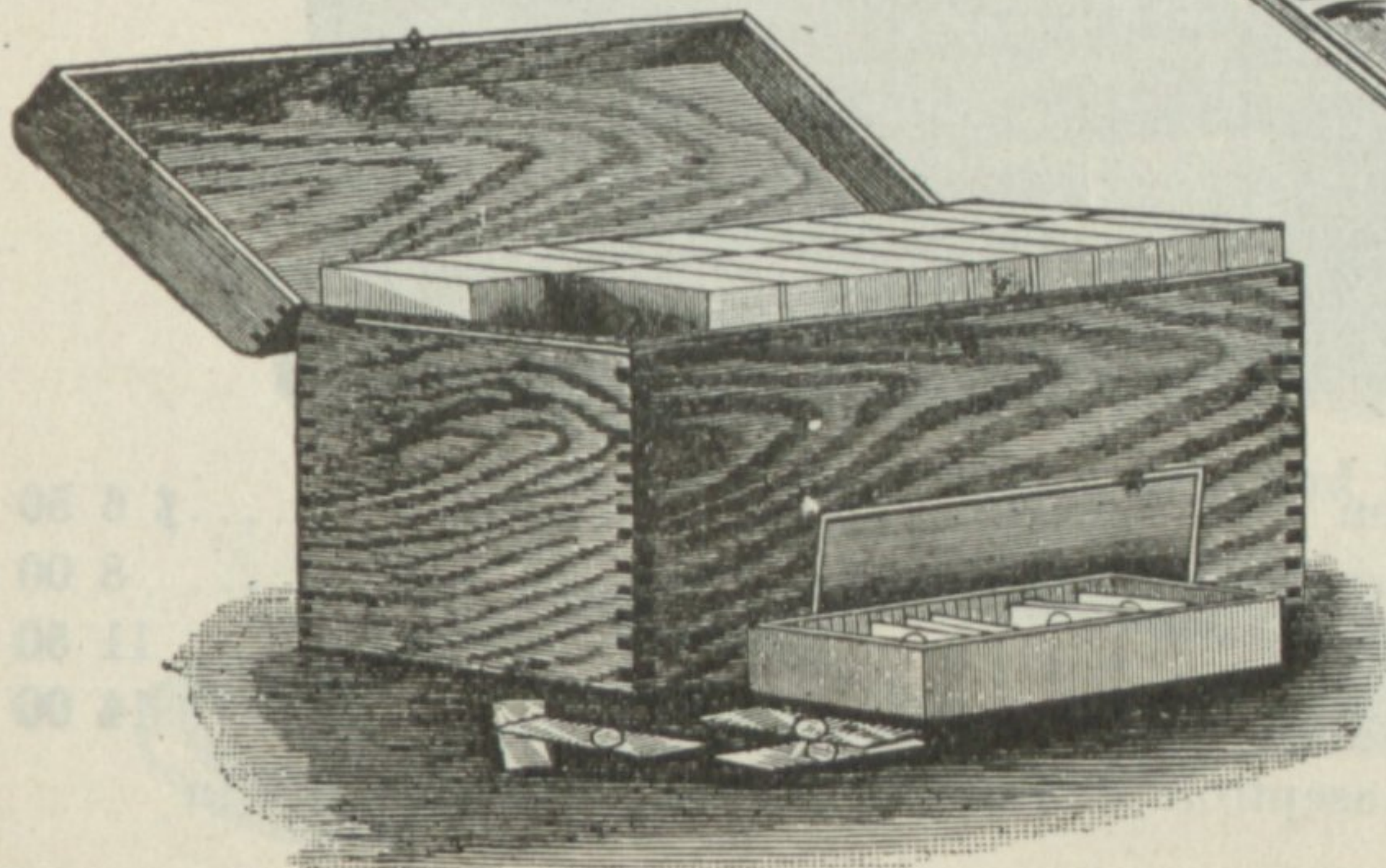
3166* **Cabinet**, upright, with handle and lock, drawer and 36 double trays, holding 432 objects..... 12 00

In producing this new Cabinet for microscopic objects it has been our aim to meet the increasing demand for a convenient and practical receptacle for a large number of slides and at the minimum cost.

The Cabinet, as shown in cut, is of cherry wood, highly polished, with paneled door and with handle and lock. The mounted objects are held in 36 wooden trays, each for twelve slides. The trays slide in grooves in the side of the cabinet, and any one or them can be examined independently of the other. There is a drawer one and one-half inches deep in the bottom of the case.
