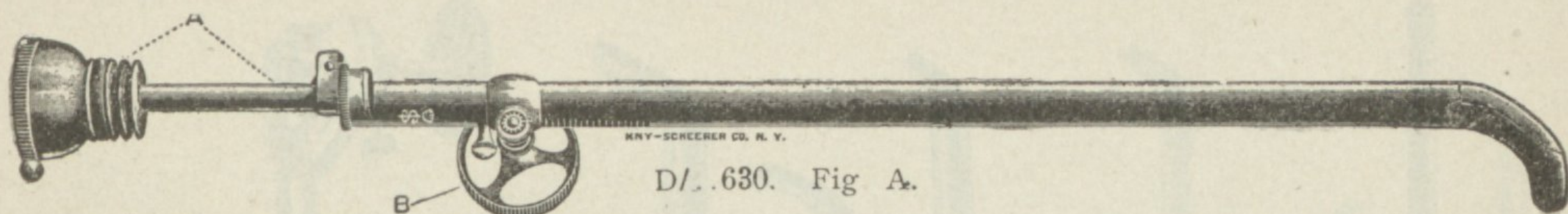
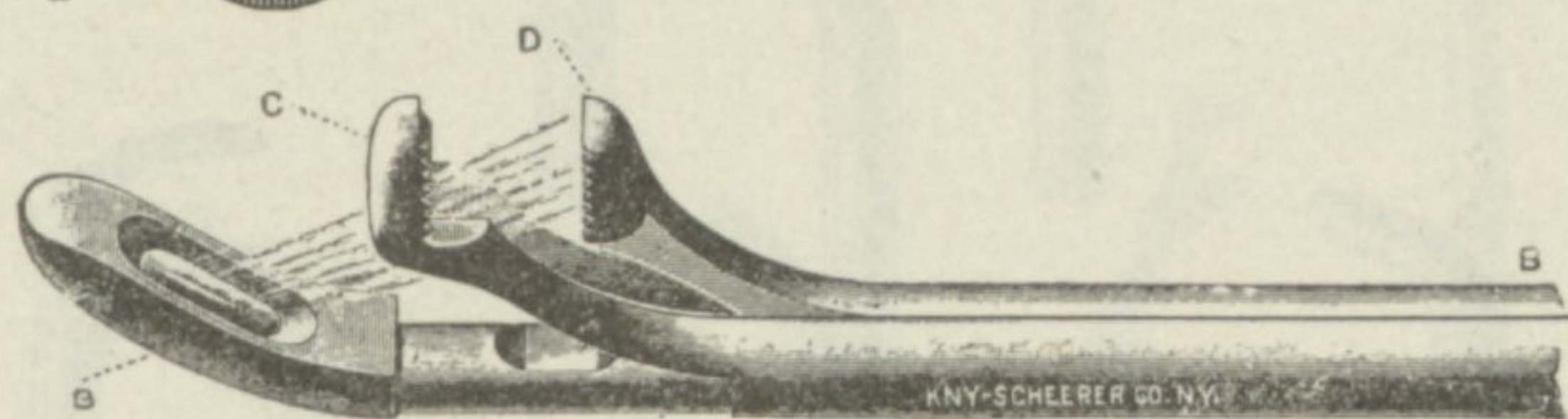


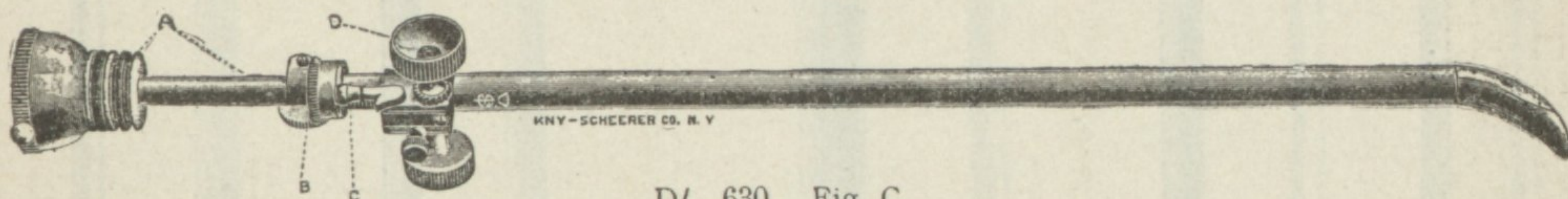

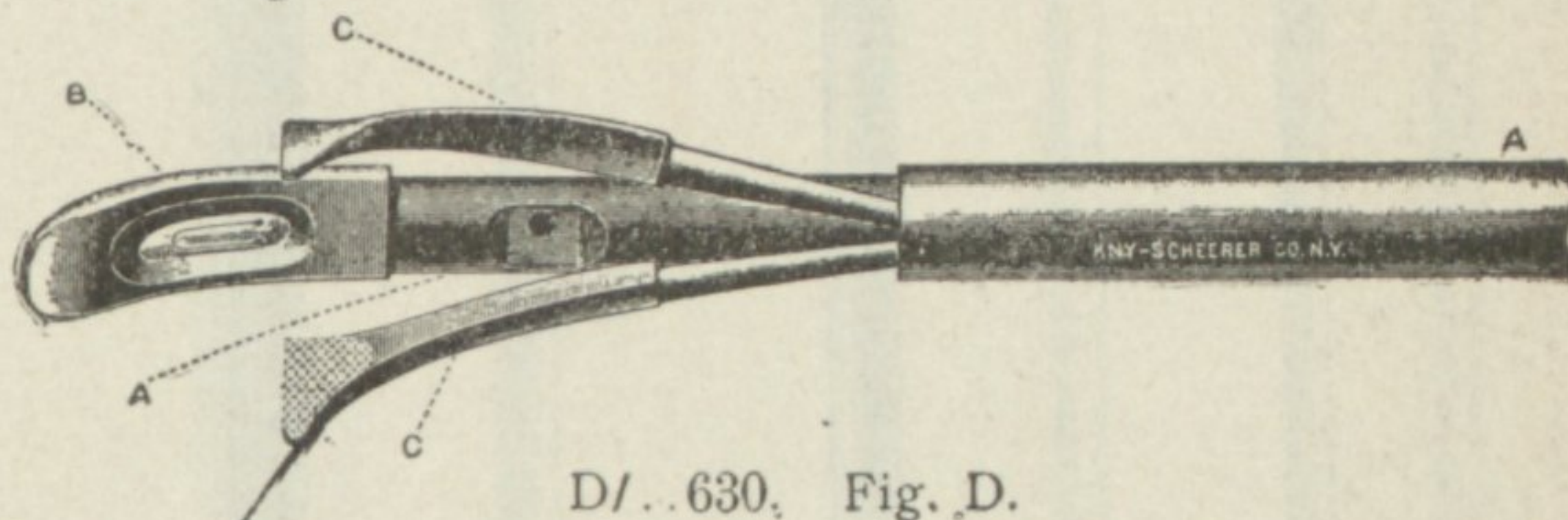

Fig. A shows the cystoscope, with lithotrite combined, ready for introduction

Fig. B. illustrates the instrument introduced into the bladder, the lithotrite opened and the cystoscopic lamp lit.

Fig. C and D illustrate the foreign body forceps under the same conditions.

The instrument consists of 1 straight tube (for the female bladder,) 2 curved tubes, fig. C (for the male bladder,) the cystoscope, fig. A and a douche tube, fig. b. The tubes permit of washing out the bladder and serve as conductors for the cystoscope.

Should the contents of the bladder become turbid, or blood or mucus affect the clearness of the prism during the examination, the cystoscope can be removed for the purpose of washing out the bladder or cleaning the prism while the tube remains in situ.

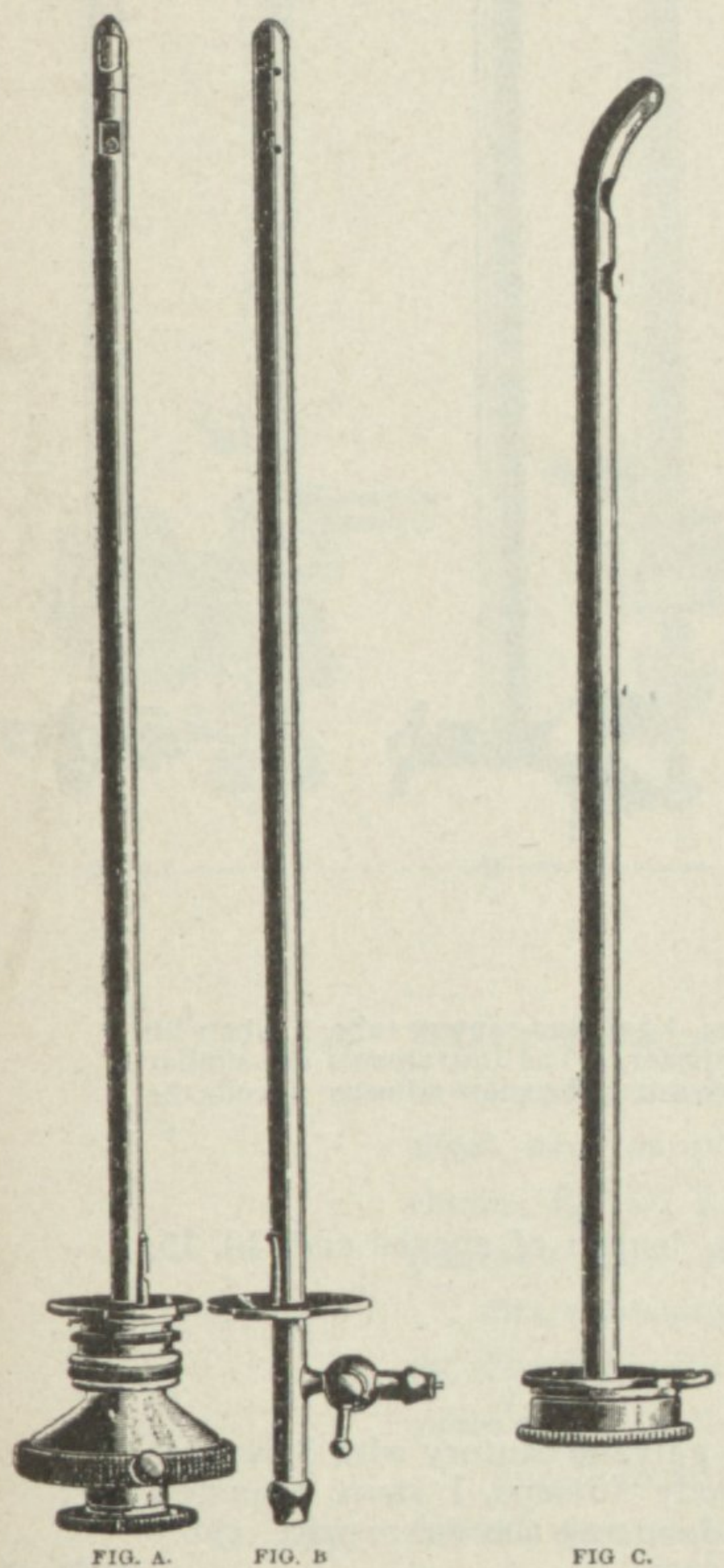
