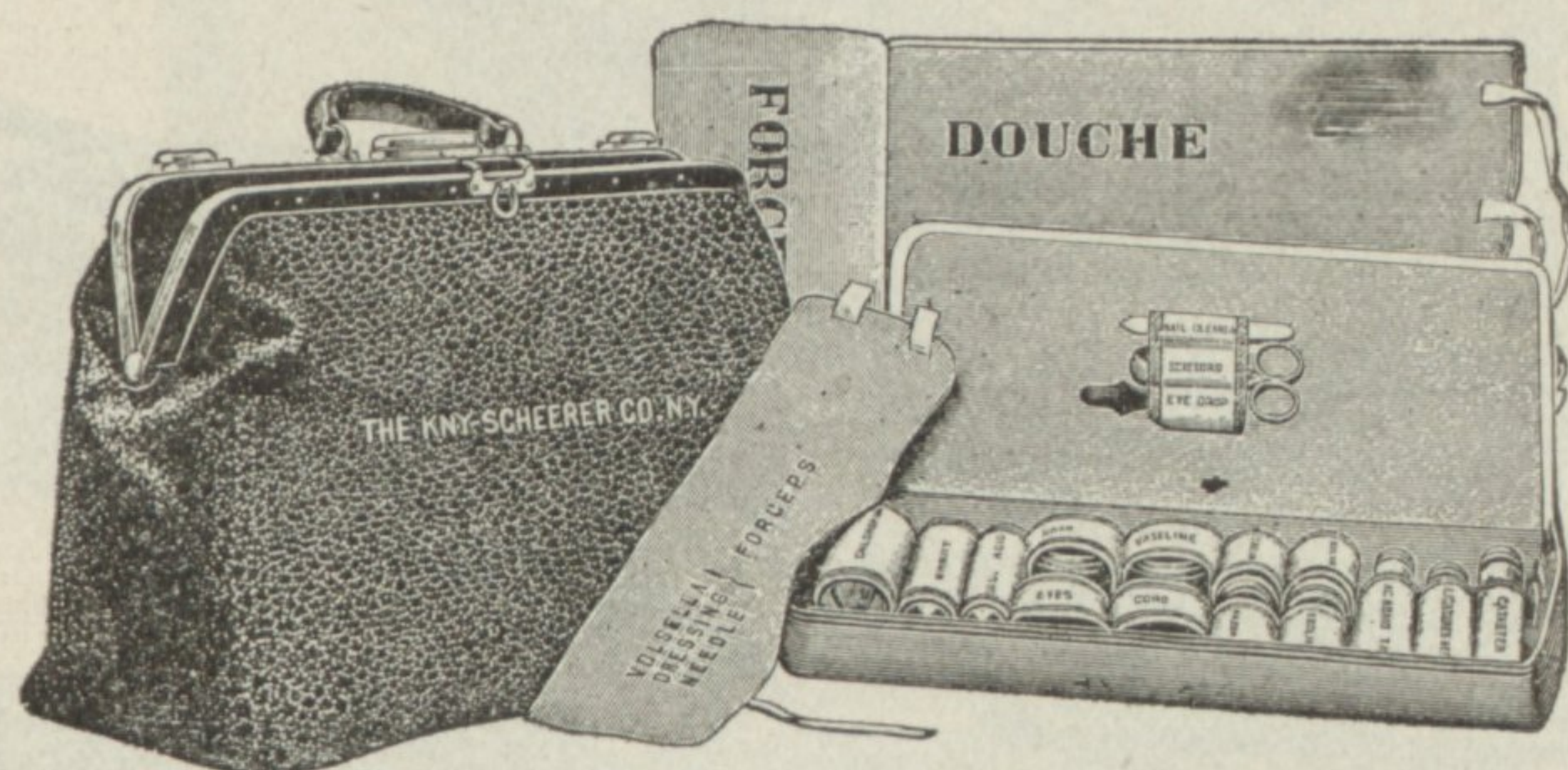

CONTENTS OF CASE.

One canvas pouch with receptacles for—

Green soap (sterile)
Vaseline (sterile)
Gauze eye sponges (sterile).
" cord dressing
Chloroform
Ergot
Acetic acid (99.5 per cent).
Sublimate tablets
Fine boric acid
Normal saline powders
Silver nitrate solution. (1 per cent).
Tape for cord (sterile)
Silk and gut ligatures and needles
Soft rubber catheter (sterile)
Umbilical scissors
Medicine dropper

Nail cleaner.
Safety razor
English catheter with stylet
Safety pins.
Sterile gauze bandage for sling
Soft braided catheter No. 8, opening at end.
Spring scales.

Seven canvas bags marked

1. "Forceps"
2. "Douche bag"
3. "Kelly's pad"
4. "Uterine dressing, volcella and needle forceps"
5. "Nail brushes"
6. "Operating gown"
7. "Lithotomy sling".

It is intended that these articles are either sterilized in the physician's office before being taken to a case of confinement, or, with the exception of the gown, boiled in the original canvas bags as wanted, at the house of the patient

Appropriate tins are provided for sterile cotton and plain gauze respectively, and a metal receptacle for glass vaginal and uterine tubes and catheter

The bag ready for use weighs 16 pounds.
