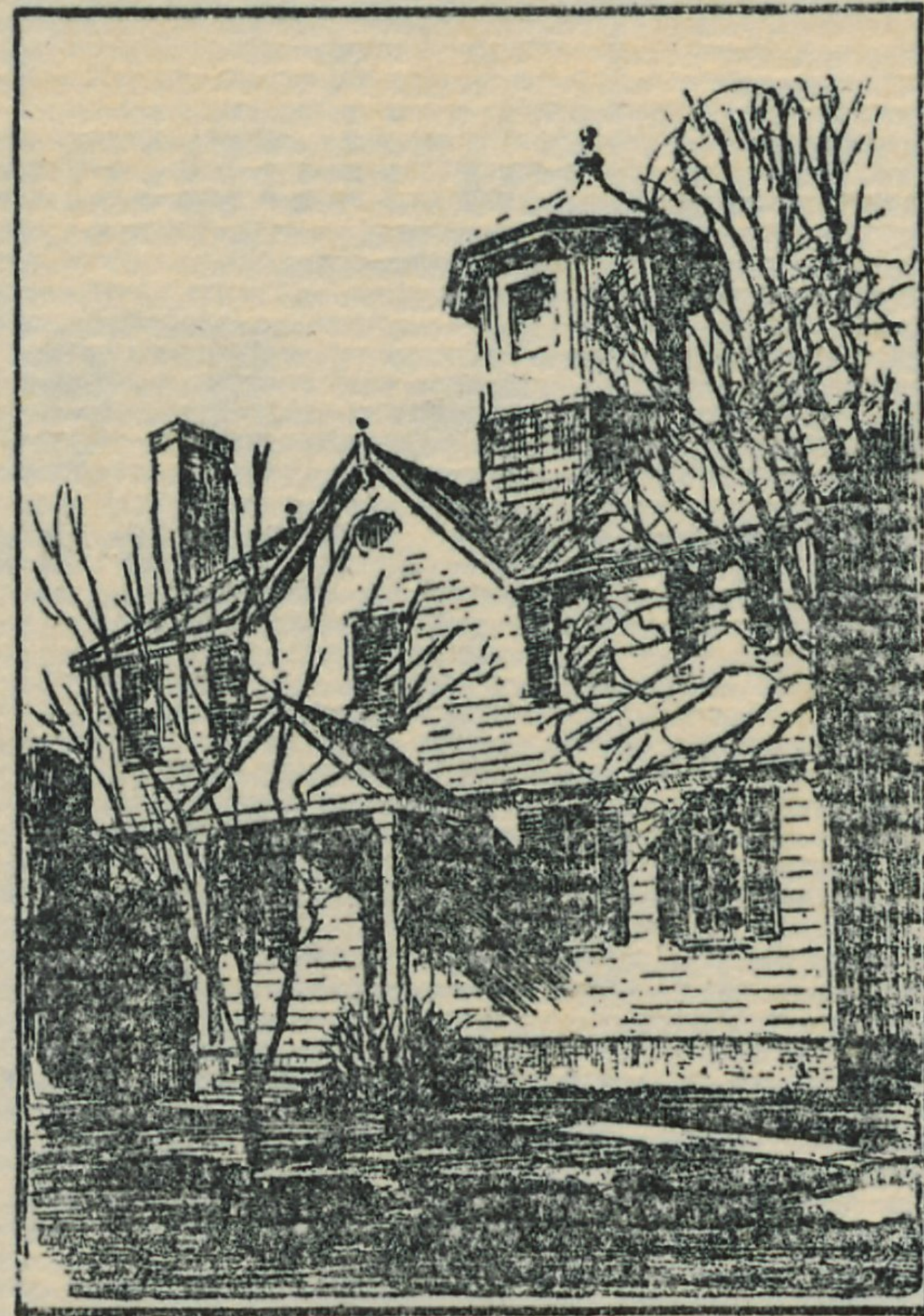

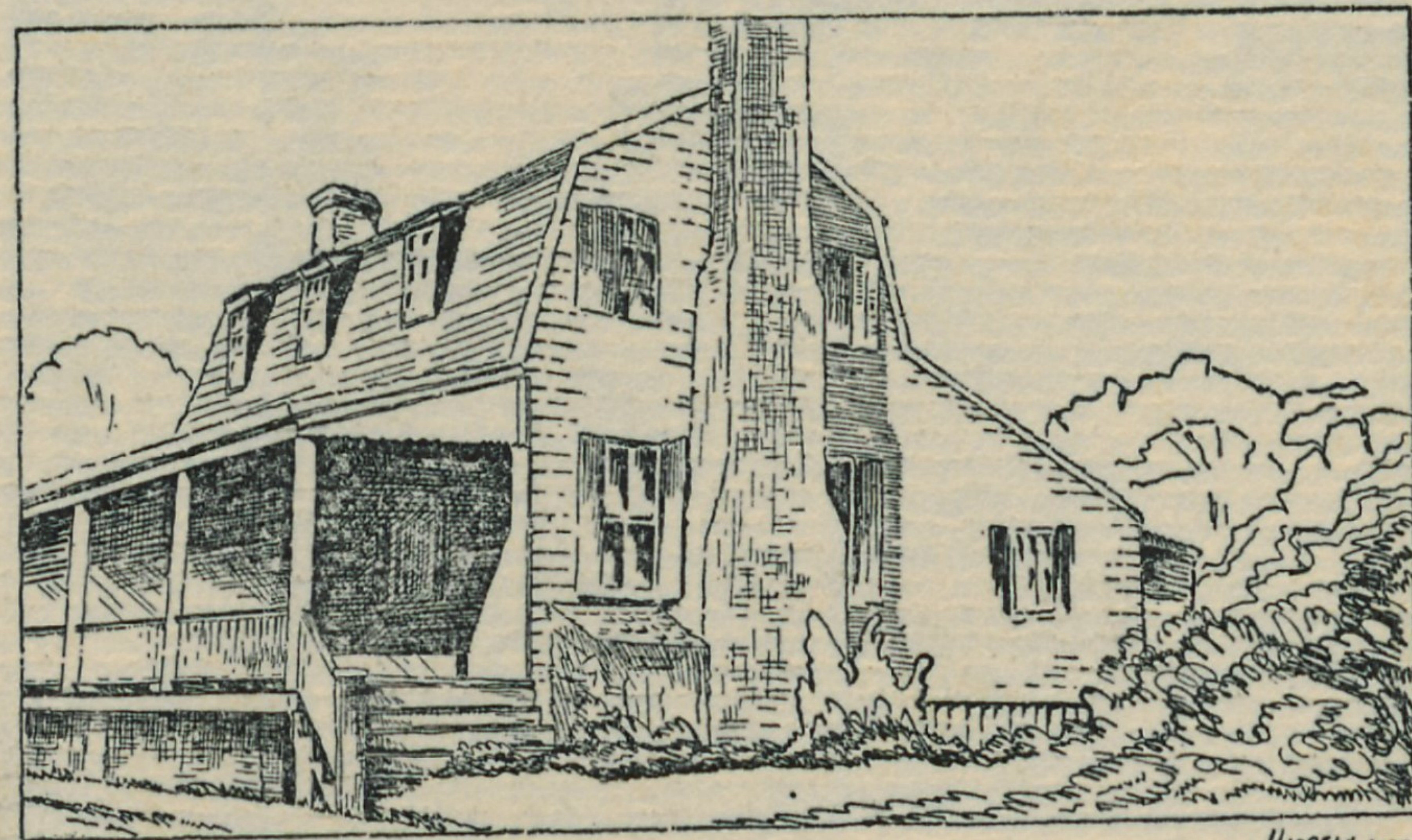

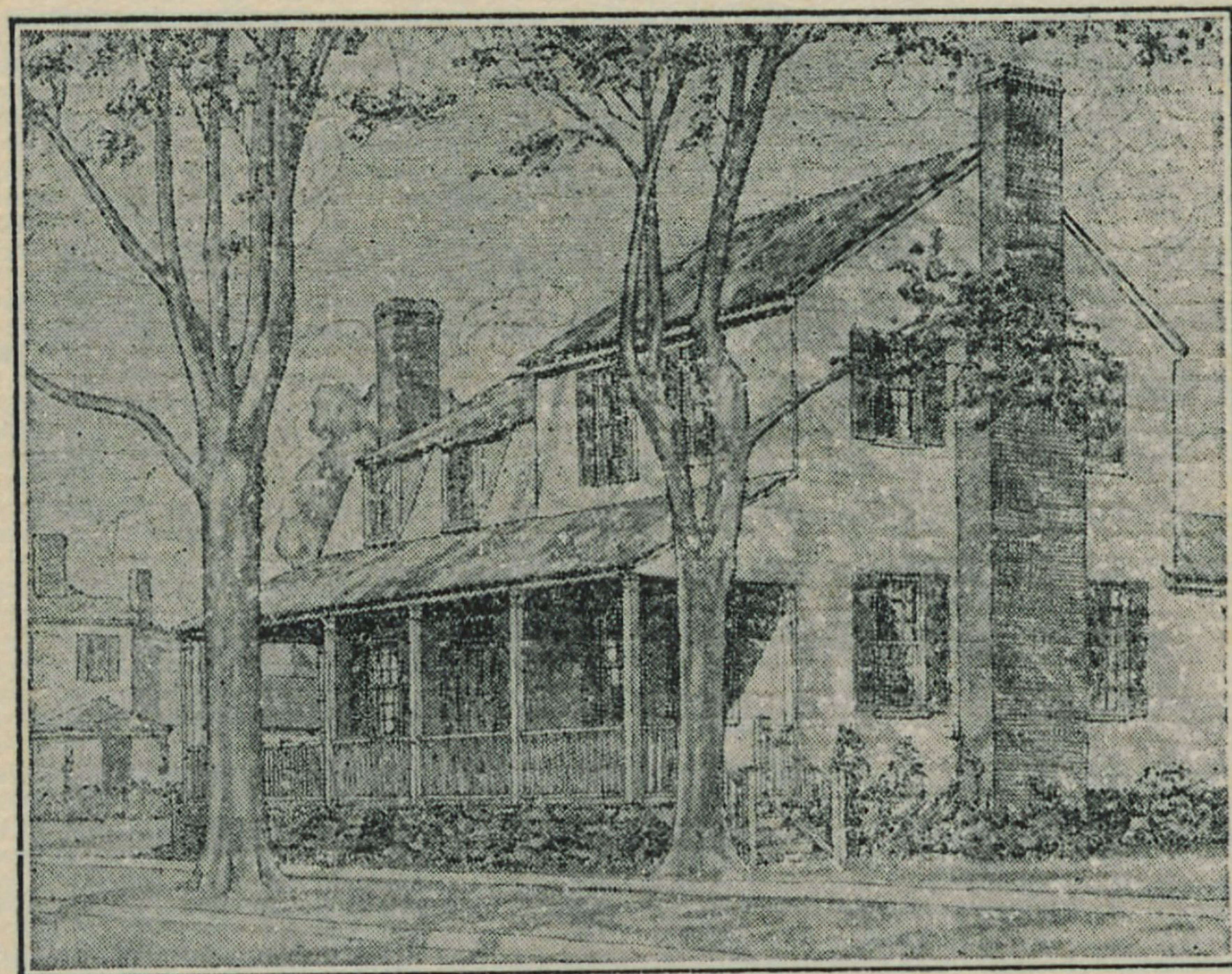

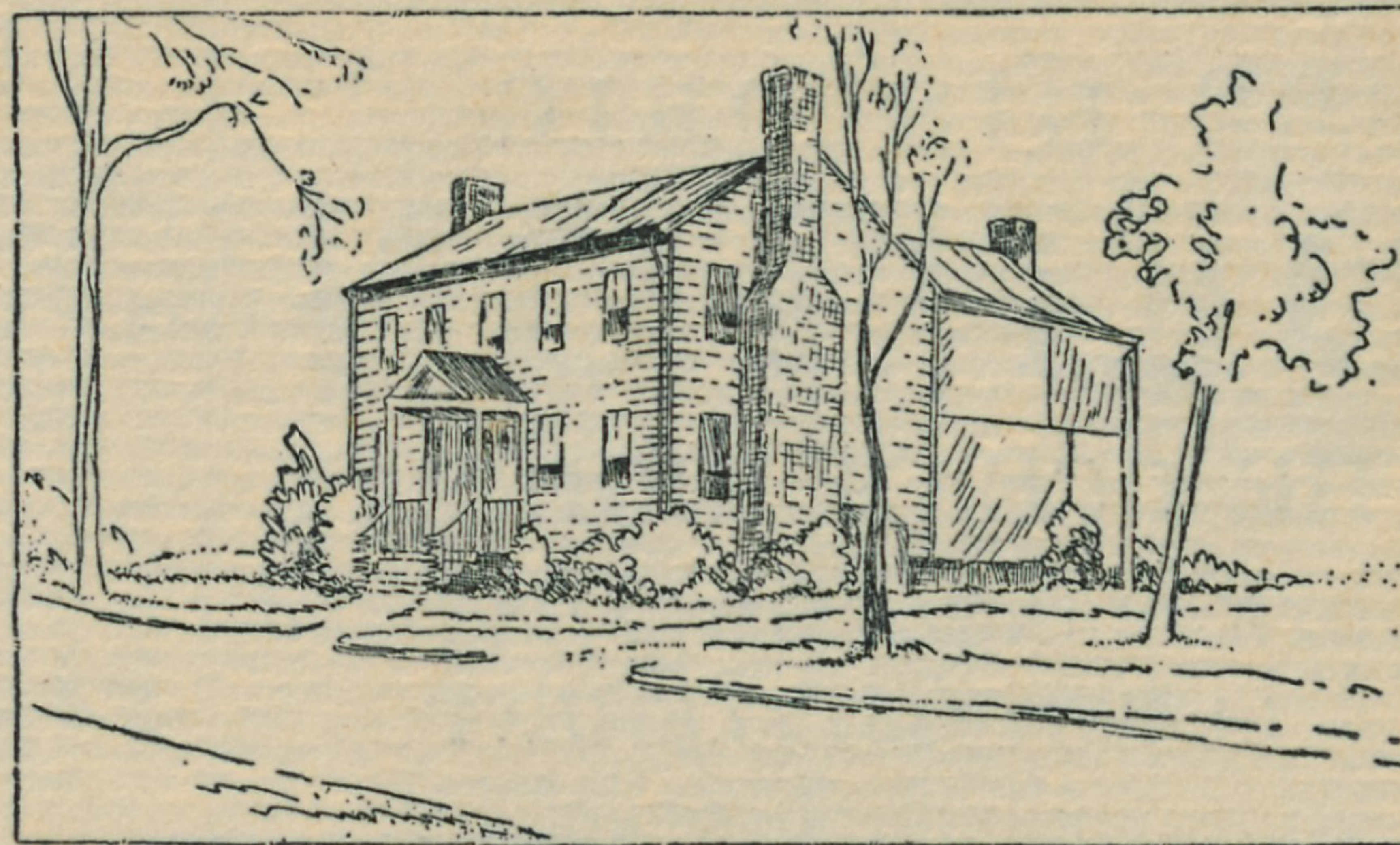
CUPOLA HOUSE—SOUTH BROAD STREET
Erected 1758. Now Library and Museum



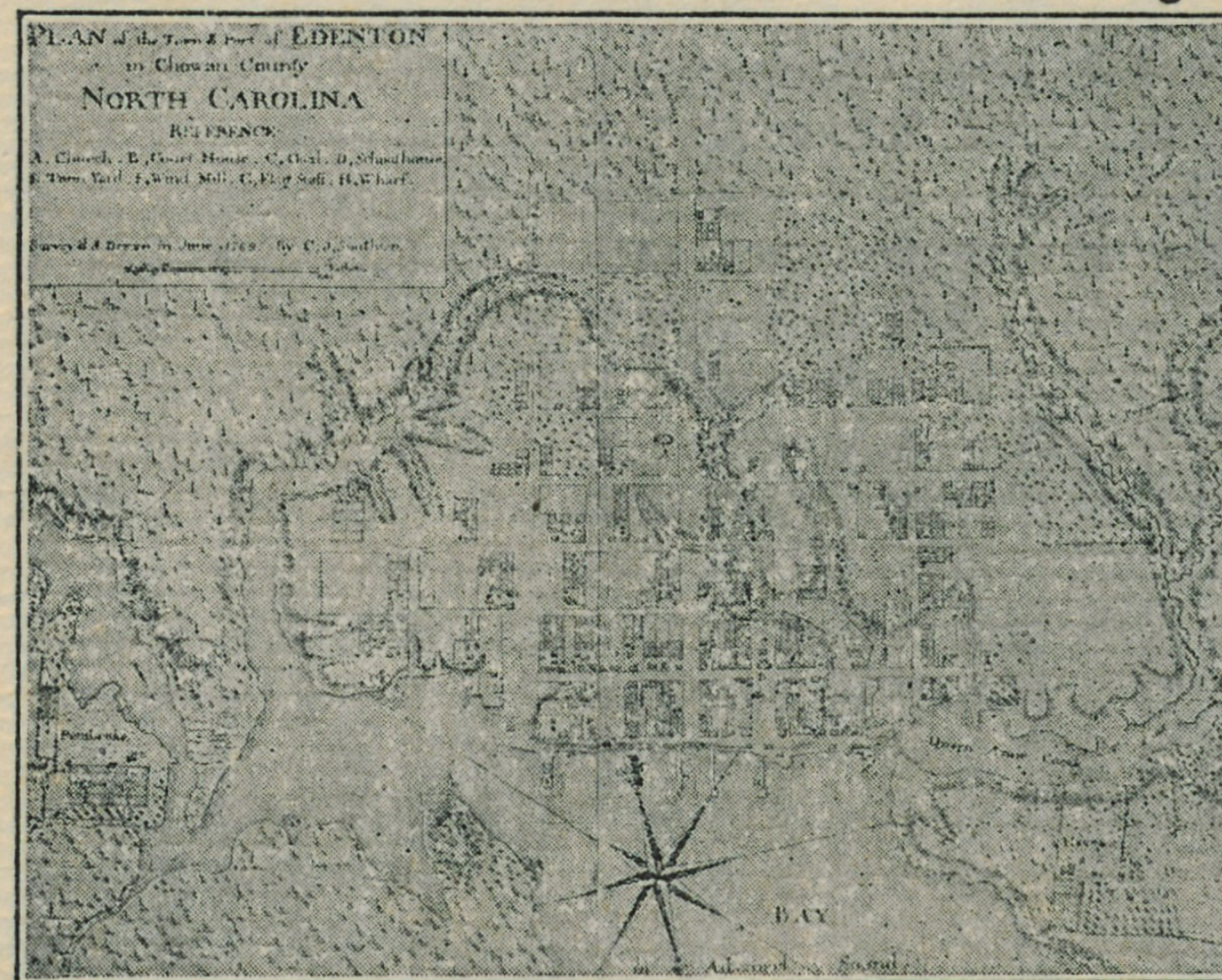
SAWYER HOUSE—WEST EDEN STREET
Erected Before 1769



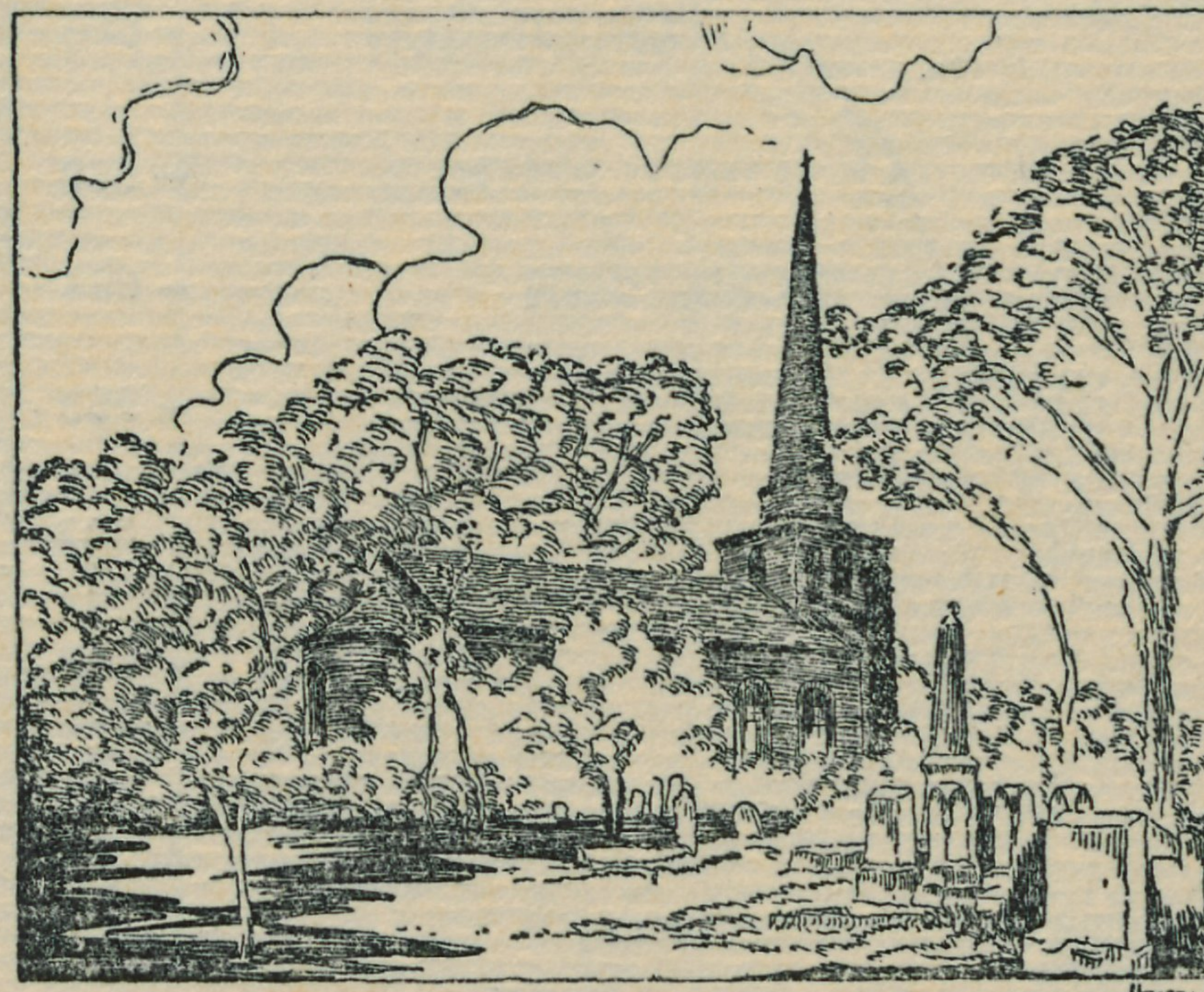
BOCKOVER HOUSE—WEST QUEEN STREET
Erected Before 1769



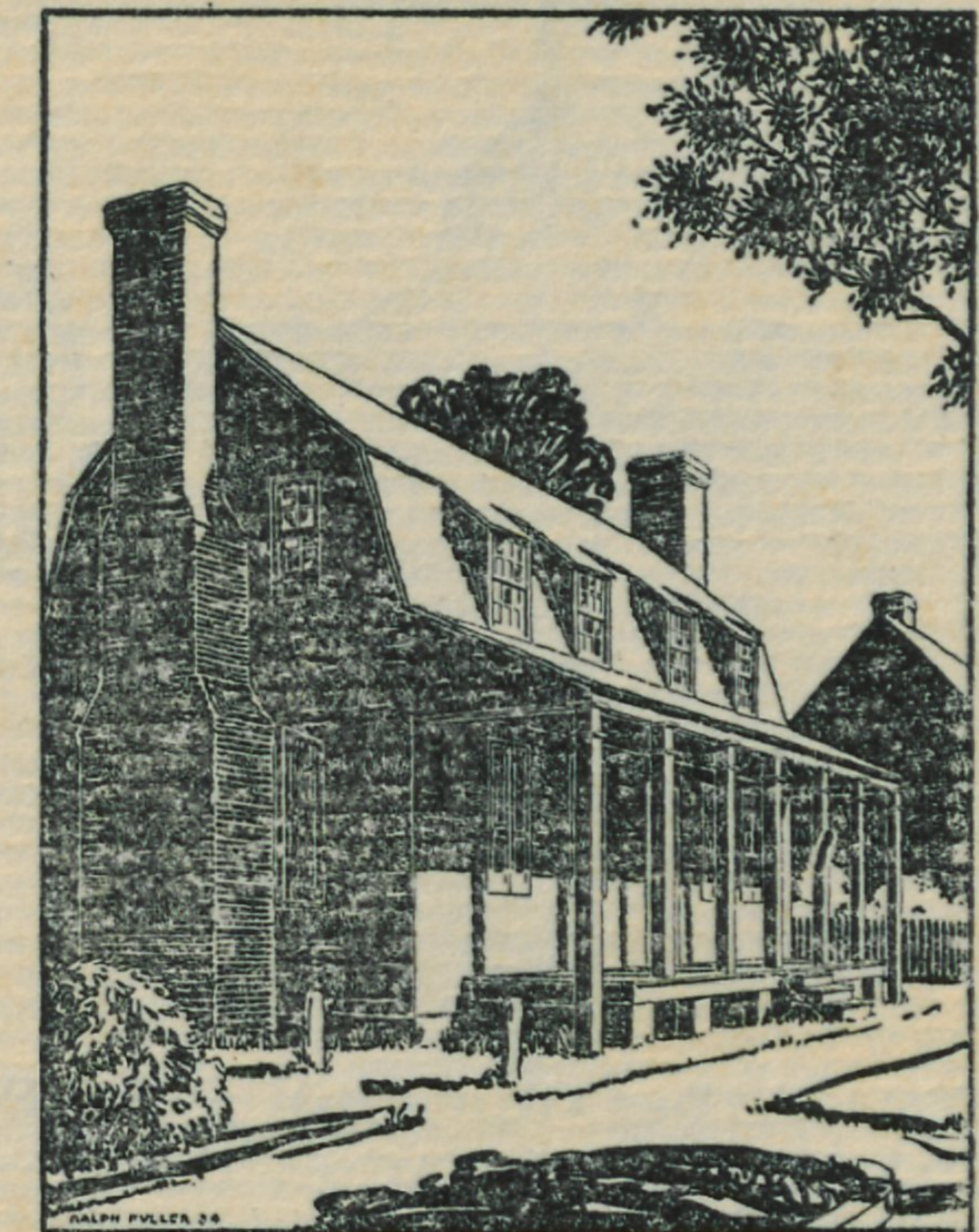
ALLEN HOUSE—WEST KING STREET
Home of Joseph Hewes, Signer Declaration of Independence. First Secretary of Navy. Patron John Paul Jones.



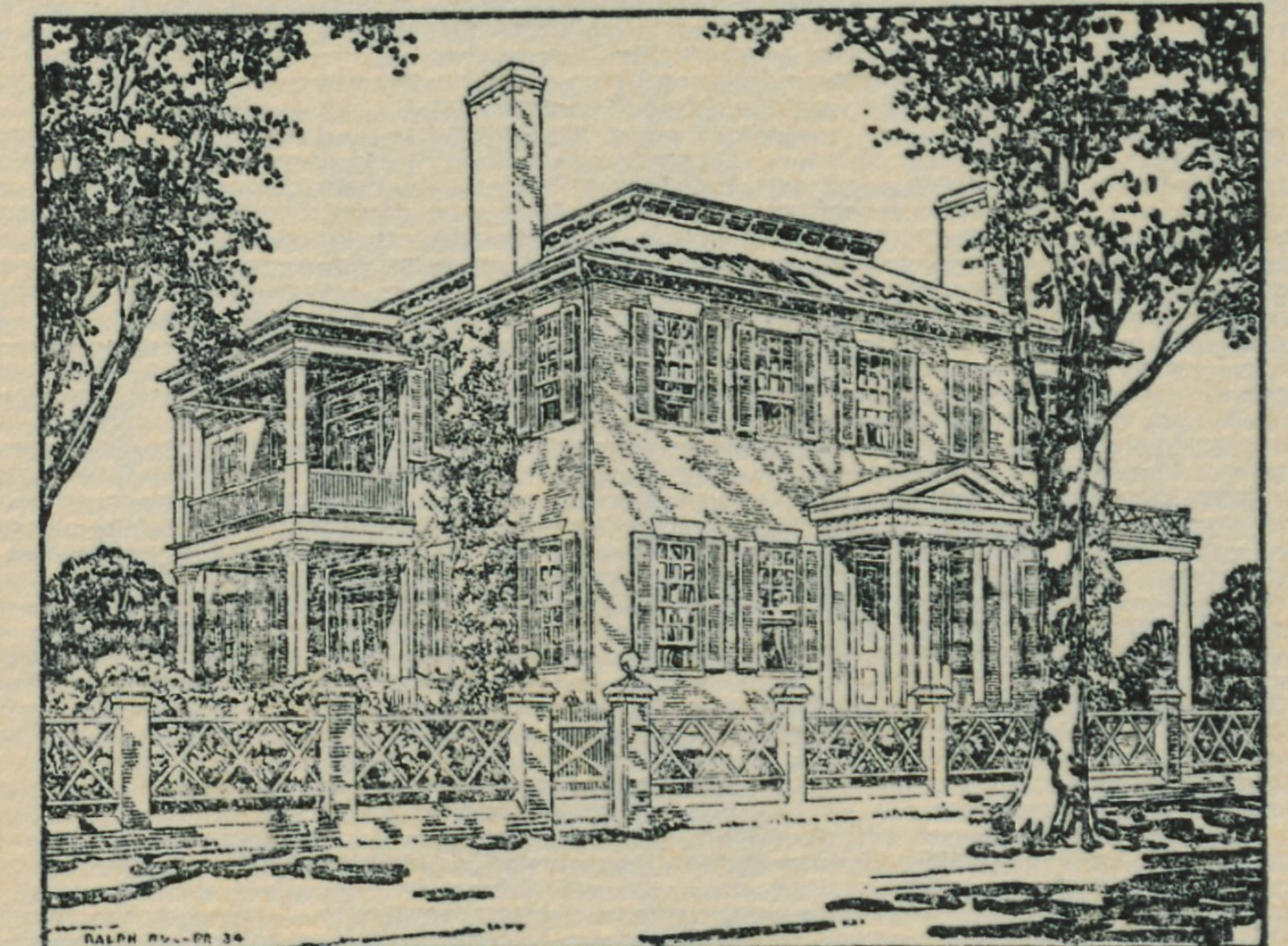
This Map Published In London In 1769 Shows Location of Most of Buildings Pictured Herein.



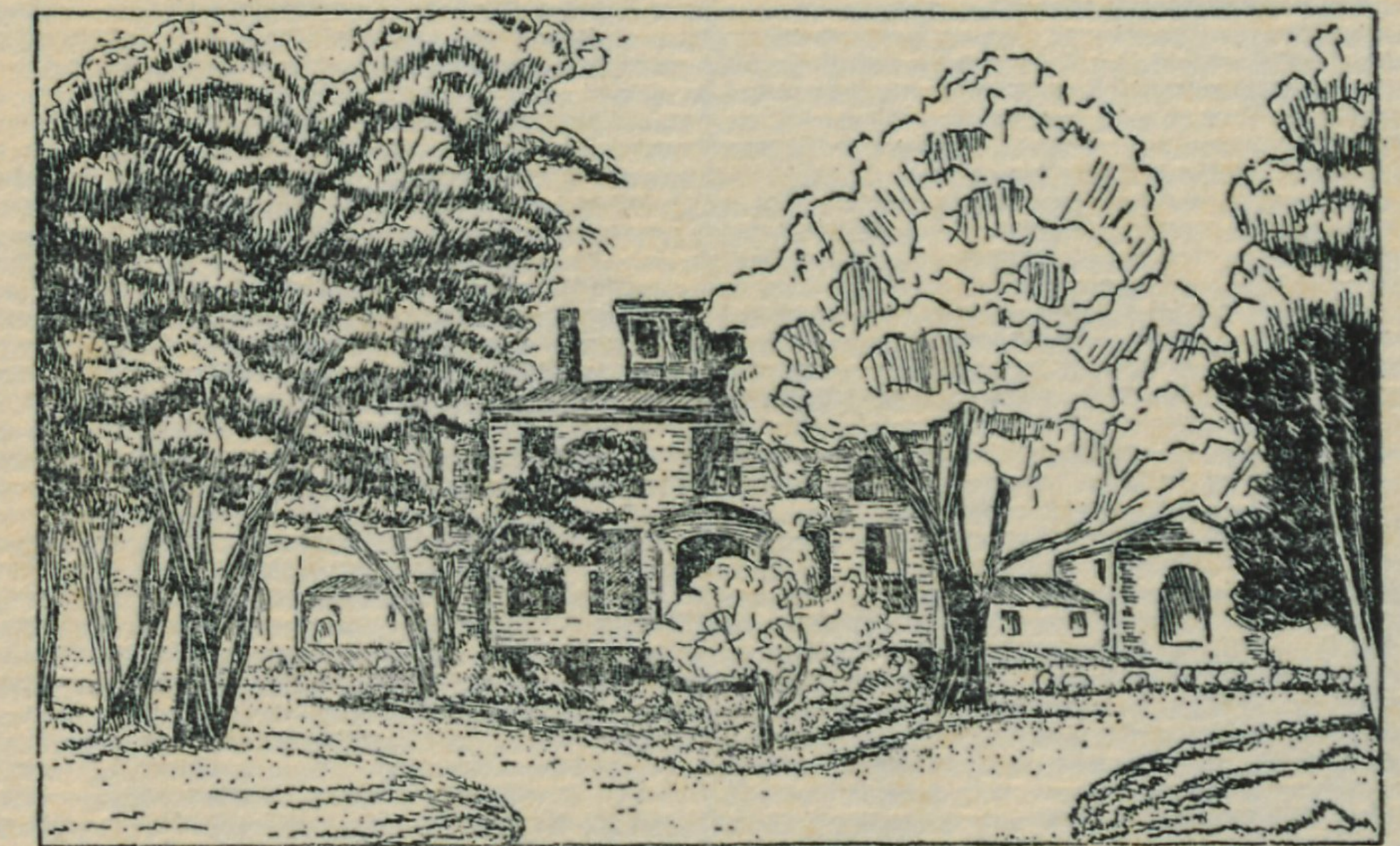
ST. PAUL'S EPISCOPAL CHURCH—BROAD ST.
Erected 1736. Two Others Preceded It. Vestry First N. C. Corporation (1701)



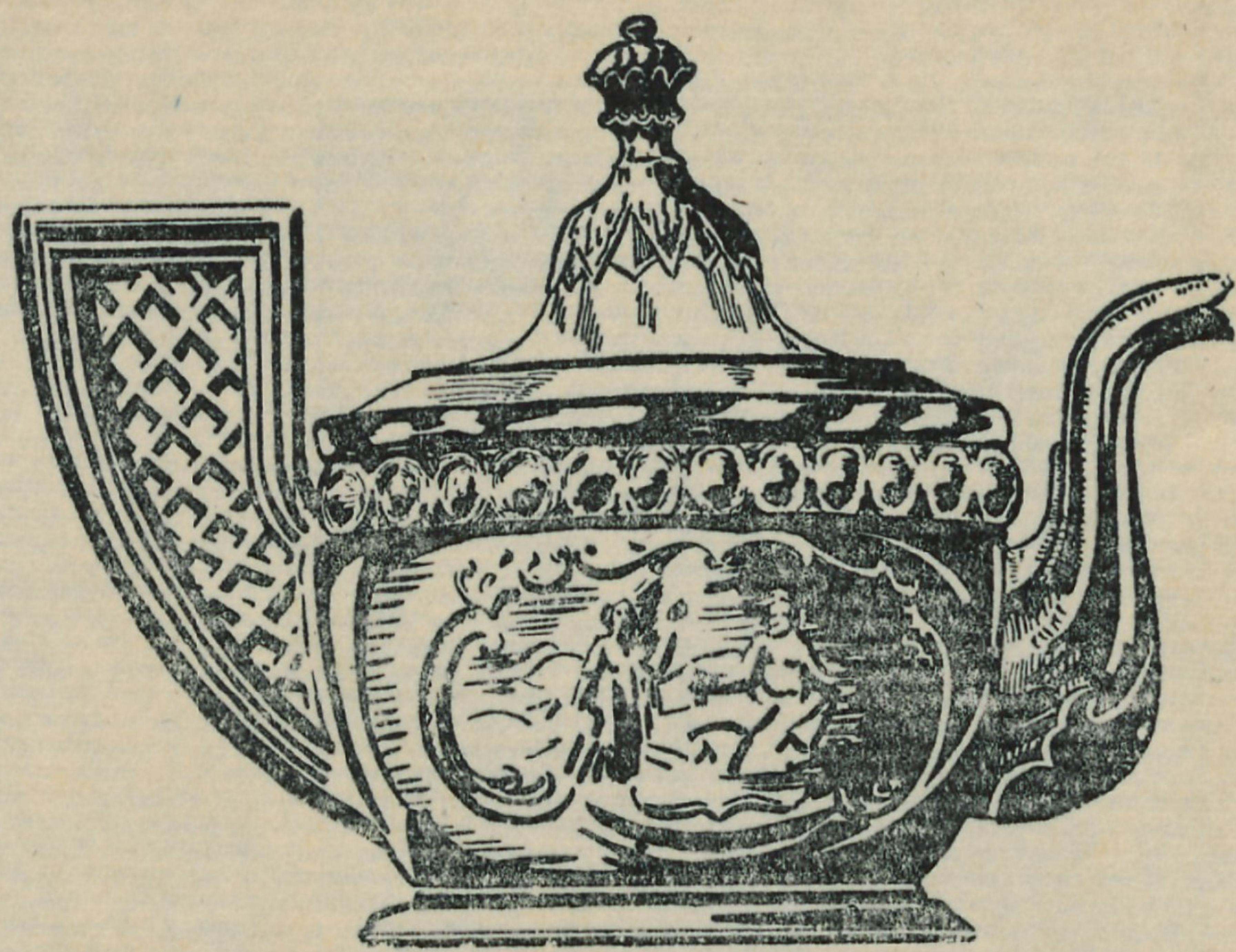
BOOTH HOUSE—EAST CHURCH STREET
Erected Before 1769.



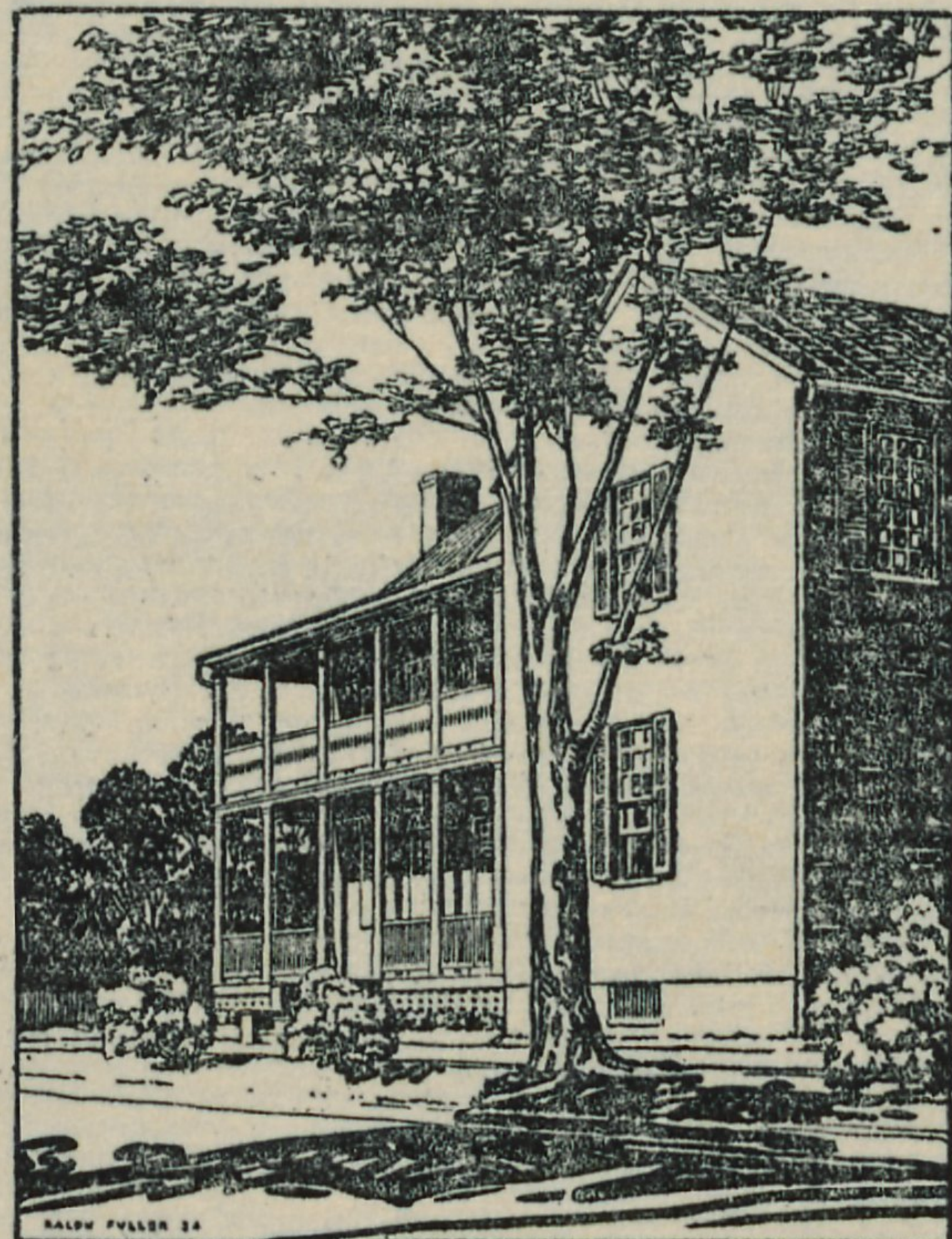
BEVERLY HALL—WEST KING STREET
Old State Bank. Bank Discontinued By Andrew Jackson.



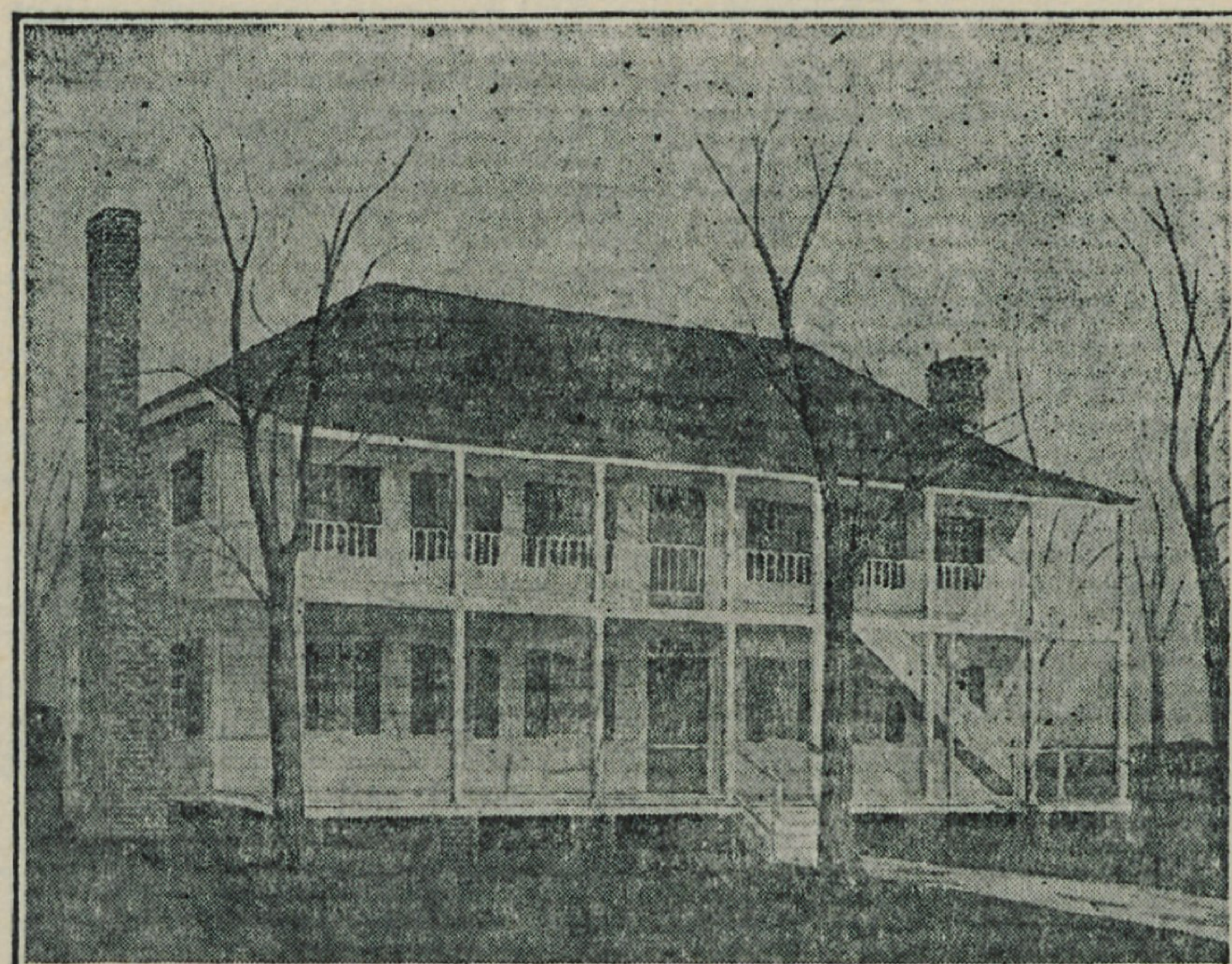
"HAYES"

 Home of James Iredell, Justice First United States Supreme Court

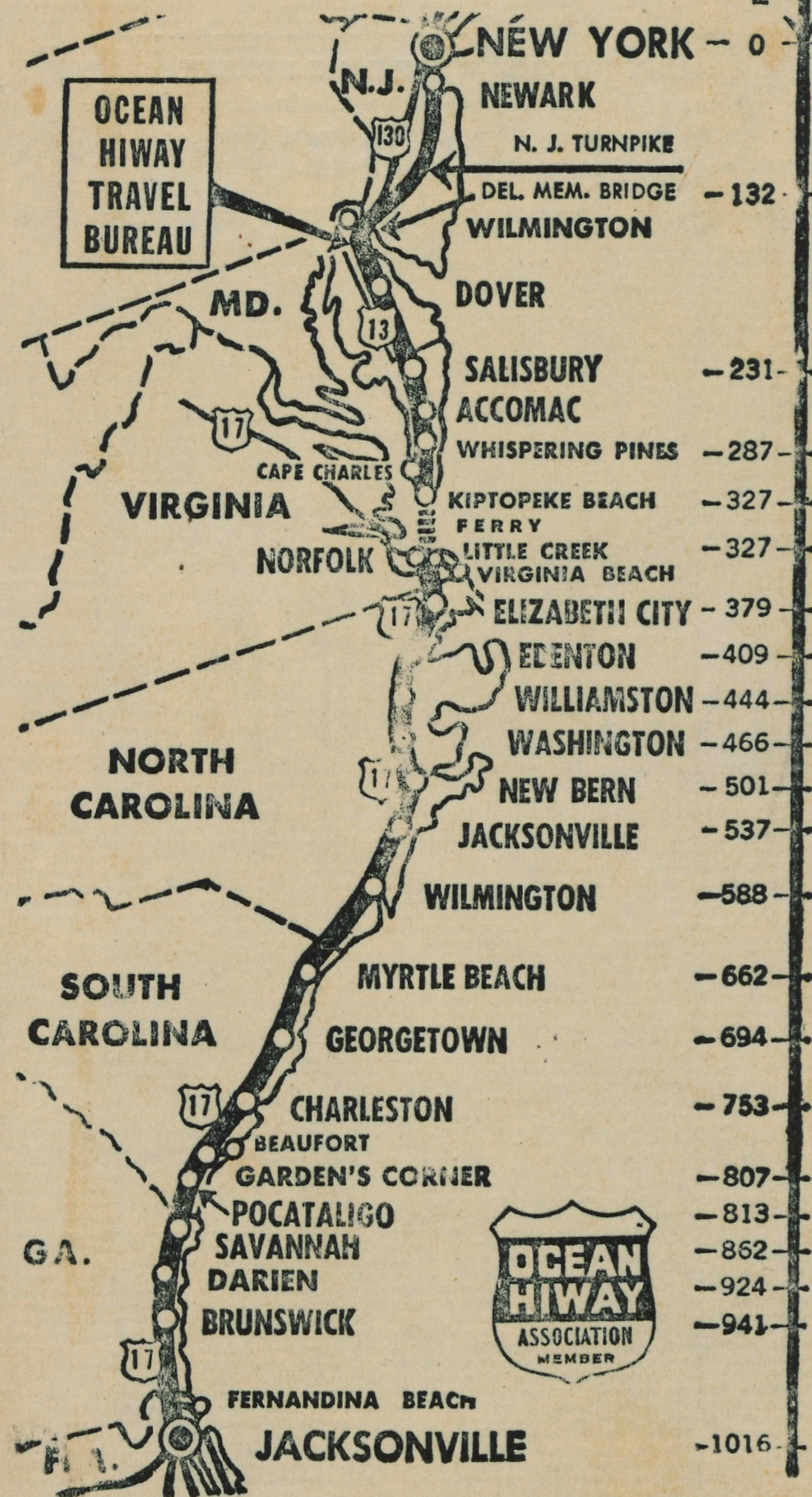


EDENTON ACADEMY—EAST CHURCH STREET

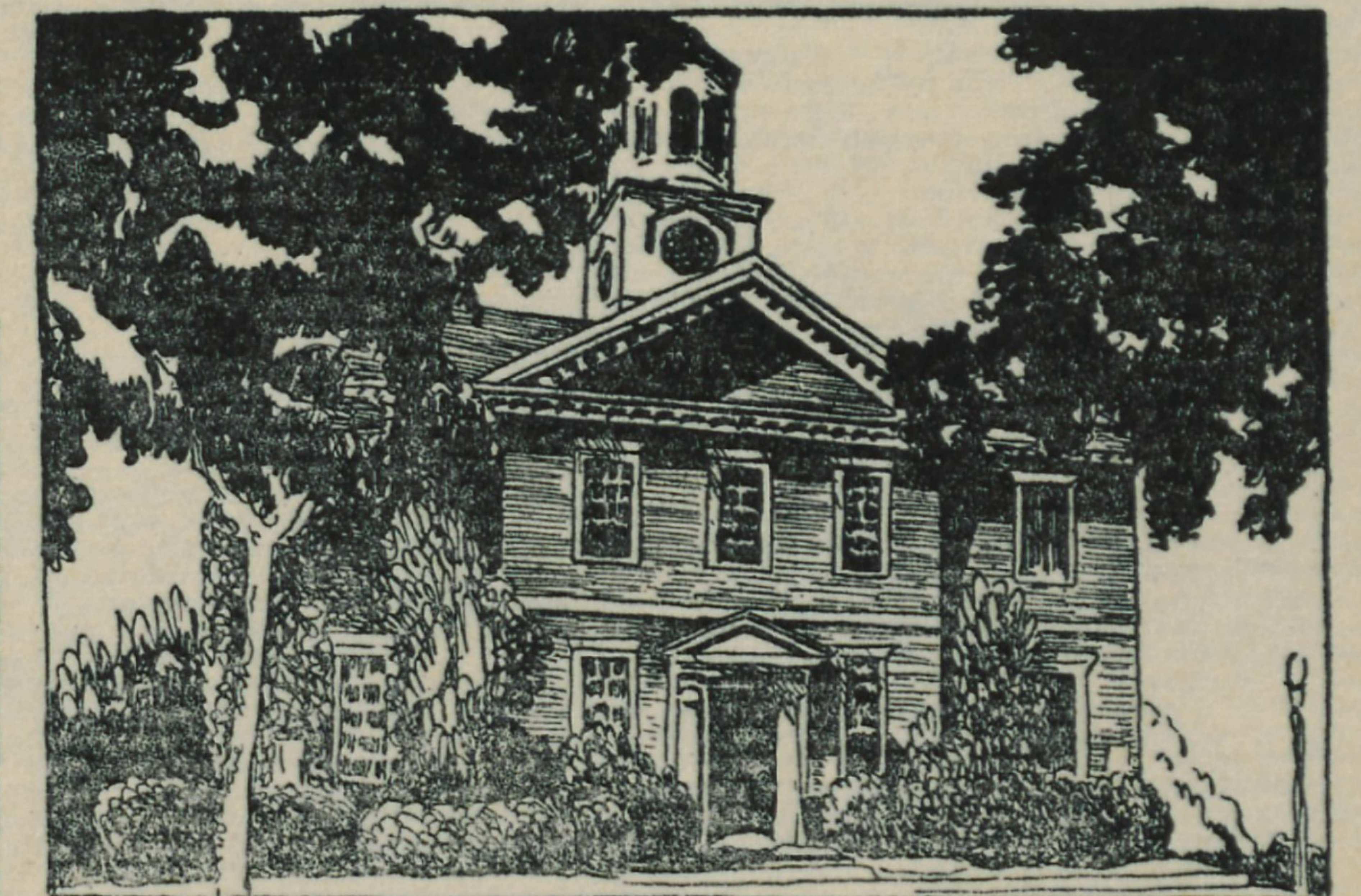
