

**The Hatteras Light House.**

Capt. Mills, engineer secretary of the light house board, has returned to Washington from an official trip of inspection to Diamond shoals, off Cape Hatteras, N. C. He reports as the results of his investigations as to the character of the sands and coast, that he found nothing to change the opinion of the light house board that it is entirely practicable to erect a light house on the shoals.

Congress has made an appropriation of \$200,000 to begin the work and limited the total cost to \$500,000. The plans are in an advanced state of preparation.

**An interesting Coincidence.**

Maj. J. W. Wilson, Chairman of the Railroad Commission, recalls to memory an interesting coincidence in connection with the election of United States Senators by the Legislature. In the General Assembly of 1885, Hon. Thos. W. Mason was in the Senate and Hon. Lee S. Overman was a member of the House. Both of these gentlemen made the leading speeches in that General Assembly, the one in the Senate and the other in the House, nominating Hon. Zebulon B. Vance for United States Senator. In the present General Assembly Capt. Mason and Mr. Overman were themselves the nominees of the Democratic party for the same high position. —Wilmington Star.
