Dear Wife I have just
returned from camp Lamb
I was detailed to go there to pick up
winter quarters our Bt was ordered
there but the order was countermanded
I suppose we will stay here a while
longer camp Lam is in Wilmington
about 2 miles from this place.

I am well I received your letter yester
day was glad to hear from you and that
you were & all well and my stock
and seeding and I hope those purliners
will find you all enjoying the same
great blessing of our great protector
in homes we trust till the better end
of this war he is willing to save all
all has great here trust in him —
it is his will that I am sure I will
try to make my self contented hoping
for better things I don't allow my self
to complain about those things
if I keep well & ^{join} go along somehow

I think this is as good a
place as I could a found in the
Confederacy it is a sickly place
There is sum small pox in this city
Sorenus Alexander get a letter from
Dr Houston stating that his wife
was bad sick I dont know whether
he will git home or not I herd down
here that Sandy O'Kinley was coming
down before long I dont think I want
any thing but a par of socks
I think you had better kill your
hogs before Crismon to save your
corn commence to care on the top of
the crib top keep the swine and
horses apart to keep posse from
eating the meal putting more
on top Take good care of your self
and do the best you can Tell friend
all body for me I wrote to mother
a letter and got no answer
I will close by telling you daddy that
