travels through this war from I
left home to I returned back
left home Sept 17th 1863
arrived at Charlotte on 18th started
to Wilmington and landed there on the 21st
then I commenced my campaign
Dec 22 left Wilmington marched
to fort Caswell, on the 11th of March
left Caswell marched back to Wilmington
Camp Lamb; left Camp Lamb and marched
out to Martins ~~borough~~ 3 miles from
Wilmington, on the 24th left Martins
~~borough~~ and returned to Caswell
on the same day; left Caswell on
the 8th of April on furlow and returned
the 19th May the 21st left
fort Caswell and marched back
to Wilmington on 22nd marched
to Masons burrows Sound the same
day; July 9th left Wilmington

and Marched to Charleston Land
the 10th on James Island, on the
22nd marched back to Willmings
landed 23rd) Oct 20th left
Willmington marched to the Sound
Camp Davis) Left Camp Davis
Nov 10 and marched to Fort Fisher
Camp Sugar Loaf, Nov 22nd
Left Sugar Loaf and march back
to Willmington) and then marched
from there to Augusta Georgia.
Landed on the 25th Nov) left Augu
Geo) marched to Pocotaligo Landed
the 1st Dec) Left Pocotaligo the 2nd
Landed the 3rd at Savannah Marched
from Savannah the same ^{day} 5th miles
four and a half Station centered
R R) on the 4th fell back 35 miles
thence marched back eight miles
on the 8th there we had a fight and
then fell back to Savannah on the
same night into the rifle pits
where we remained under fire
till the fall of Savannah the
20th Dec, thence ^{fell back} marched to

Harderille; Left Harderille on the
25th Dec and fell back to Pocotaligo
Left Pocotaligo 14th January and fell
back to Sattatchie River; Feb the 3rd
fell back to the ^{Geo} RR on the 4th and 5th
we retreated back to Branchville
from there we marched down the
Edisto River 5 miles from thence
down the RR to Ridgeville 17th Feb
from thence to the River Bridge on
the Charleston RR from thence to
Florence from thence to Chesaw,
and there we crossed the Pee Dee R.
from there to Rockingham N.C. and
from thence we marched on to
Smithfield on the Centennial RR
and from there we fell back to
~~Guilford~~ Randolph County where we was
Surrendered.
