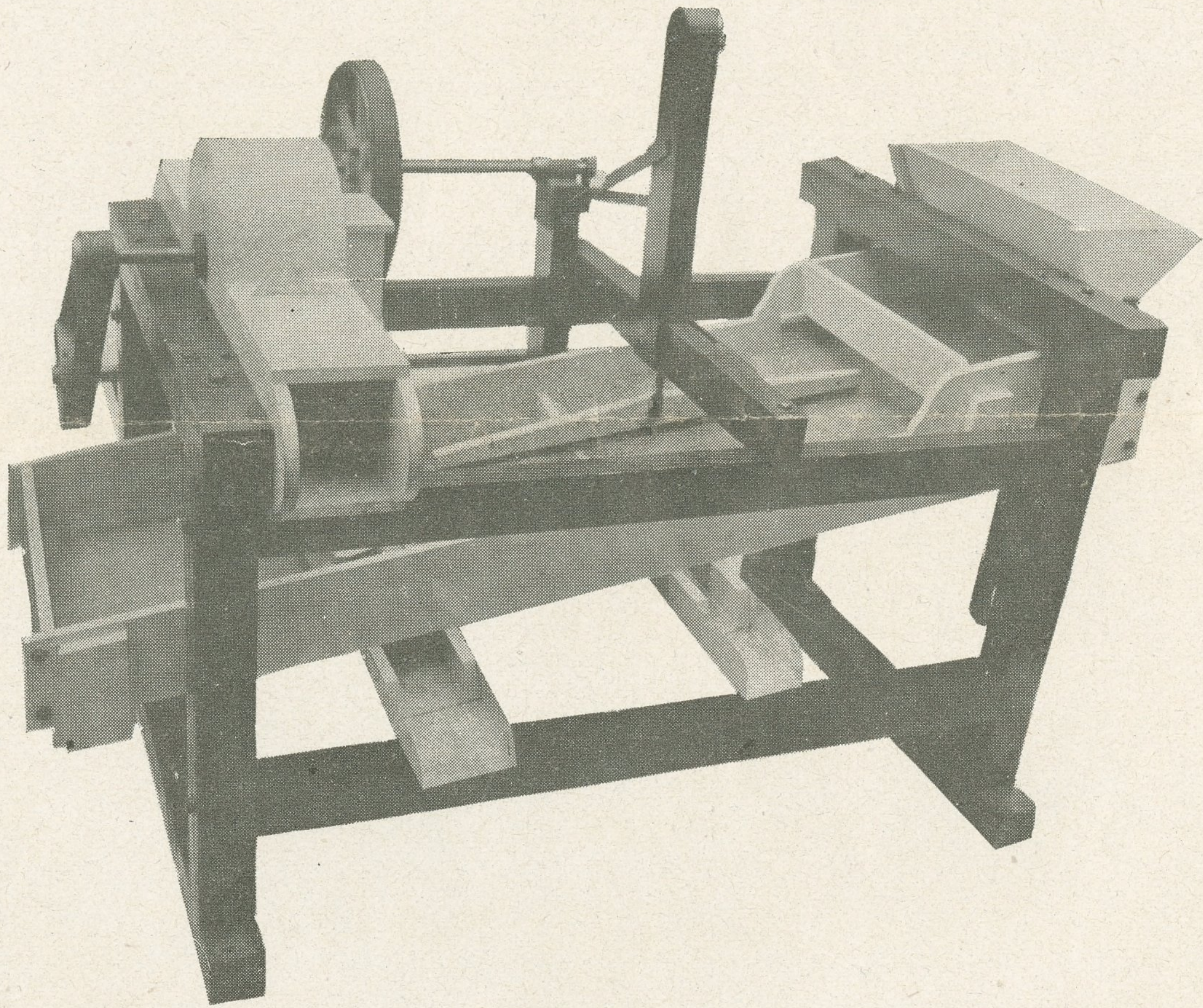

The frame is constructed of selected yellow pine, liberal in dimensions, mortised and securely bolted together, making it rigid and durable. The workmanship and material throughout are guaranteed.
