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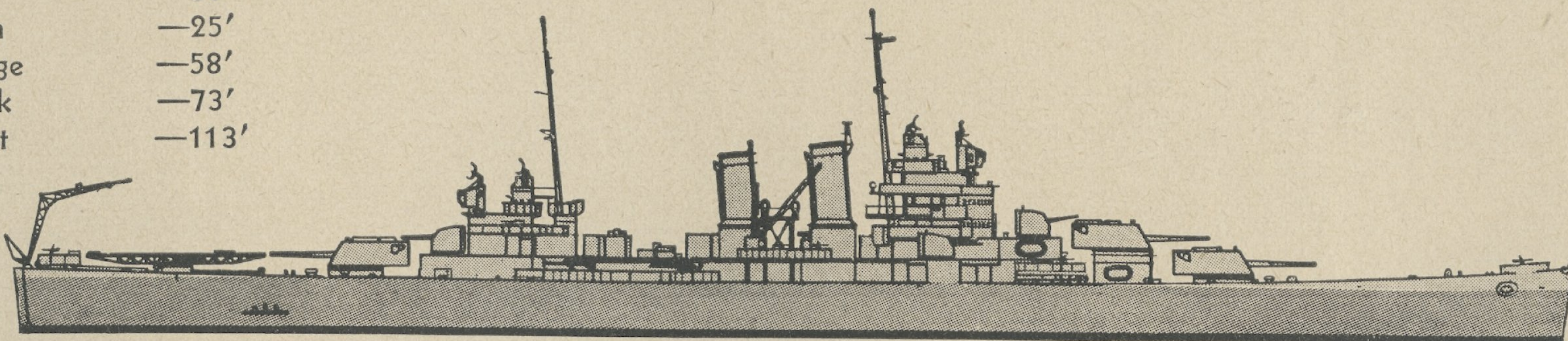
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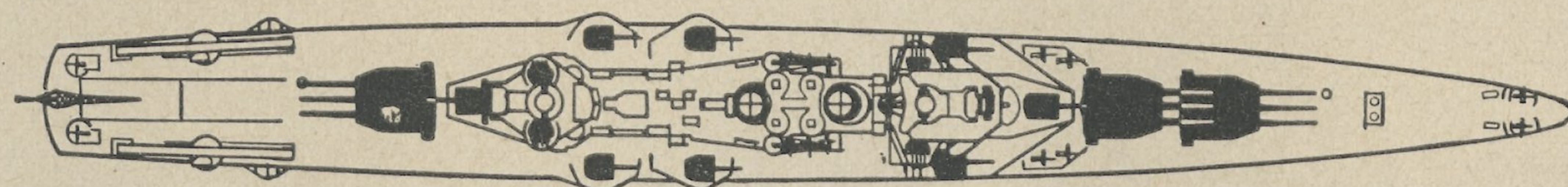

- Two closely spaced, raking stacks, pole masts.
- 2-A-1 main battery arrangement; note superimposed secondaries.
