send you the 50 Bales together with the Corn
Sheller, We enclose Circular made up to
Friday Night, since which the News from
Liverpool is very bad, the price has declined
nearly $\frac{1}{2}$ Penny since the Circular was made
up, our market is very unsettled, the trouble
now seems to be a sort of War Panic in Europe,
we have not been able to sell any Cotton
for several days, 26 $\frac{1}{2}$ is about fair quotation
