When at your house I was very much taken with a gate you were then making. I would be very glad for you to mark out a pattern on paper and send it to me as I have several to make. - I was in Warren work before last I believe all were well at the old man's. I think his and Gran Ma's health is as good as it has been for a long time they were both looking quite well. the frequent and heavy rains. have delayed farming operations very much with us - hope you have escaped them. - I suppose you and Aunt El will be up the country shortly - you must be sure to come and see us. write soon - with love to El & the children -
