I have just had an interview with
Sheppard in regard to the claims of Davis vs the
estate of Jas A. Williams - He proposes to
give me in settlement, any claims that
he has belonging to the estate, and offered
the following, which he supposed to be
good -

I think it advisable to settle in this
way - I do not know the standing of
J.M. Jenkins, Monk Moore, Henry Belcher
F.G. Pitt or Wm. Scott, but the other
notes are perfectly good, and you
can advise me as to these - Some
of the claims as you will see were
given during the war, if I take any

of them, of whom I will make all
proper deduction —

mail — as I said before — I think it
advisable to decline or rather to
accept the proposition — ~~which~~
will be guided by your friend
