Dear Ell

I write you a few lines to let you hear from me I am now at Burlington came to day from Barn I stand a week down in the fork and a week at Henrys I got along there very well They had a very comfortable little room up stairs Polly will move home to Franklin in a week or two this place well look very lonely when she leaves it makes me feel melancholy when I think of it Plummer and Sam got back safe they sent the little trees by them but they were so small we thought they had better be planted in the garden until they grow large enough to set out in the yard

Henry returned home last evening from down the country I stayed with Sam while he was gone through mistake I opened Sarah letter she wrote that the school had not commenced but thought it would before long write for her Ma to send her clothe and her Dols she seemed to be very well satisfied I will get All to see about the fodder when he goes to town I am sorry to hear Lu is so unwell hope he is well by this time give my love to Liza and the children and tell them ^{the children} they must write often Delia baby has been quite sick and Reys very unwell I saw Mr Clements yesterday and sent Sarah letter by him

wrote often and let me hear from you well
I will close as I have nothing interesting to
write all I own me in love Farewell may
