Dear Sir

I have one Holstein Cow not more than seven years old I think hardly that she is a large cow and with good care will give 4 Gallons of good milk per day if milked twice a day. She has a heifer calf by her side sired by a full blood Jersey Bull - dropped last May

I have one medium sized cow six years old with June I think. She is out of a Registered Ayrshire cow by a registered Jersey Bull - this is a fine cow and gives good rich milk I have milked from her 14 quarts milk per day. Dr. James (now dead) had this cow and refused \$100. for her. I purchased her after his death for \$500. She has no calf though
over

she is now giving milk about six quarts
per day without proper treatment. Her mother
gave over 4 Gallons milk per day and I
am certain she will do as well if nicely
treated color fawn and white - I have also a
nice half Jersey Heifer 3 years old the 10th day
of each April nearly solid dun color. She dropped
a calf the 11th day of last March and gave
before she was 2 years old 9 Quarts milk
per day. is giving now, so my milker says, 5 Quarts
per day. with good care she will do better
She is out of a good cow said to be a mix-
ture of Devon Ayshire and Native - In own
line now but do not know her breeding.

This heifer is now with calf by a Jersey Bull
I think but am not sure of it. The first
two cows mentioned are not with calf
as I have kept them up I will take
for the 3 cows including the Holstein cow's
calf \$1400⁰⁰ except the calf \$125⁰⁰. If you

cow has a long and I think ill shaped
udder though when you see it full of
milk you lose sight of its shape. Both
of the others have nice square udders.
They are all nice cows and cheap at
the price - I do not care much to sell
the Jersey Heifer as she is a sort of family
pet - but have moved from country to town
and have more than I want and there
there are the best I have. Let me hear from
