My Dear Sir:

At the last meeting of the Board of Trustees of the A. & M. College, - when we all regretted the necessary absence of yourself & Capt. Alexander, - this record was made:

"Mr. Fries moved that the Finance Com. be & is hereby instructed to examine the finances for the ensuing year, and whenever in their discretion the condition of our funds warranted it, they shall prepare a report, and the President of the Board shall call a meeting of the Trustees to consider the execution of additional building for mechanical purposes."
