We feel that we have deviated from the straight path today in using the \$5000 notes which you sent us to renew the \$5000 note favor of The Importers & Traders Nat. Bk maturing Oct. 11th but we had overdrawn at bank and we had but little in notes in our safe and it was all but a case of necessity. So we sincerely trust, under the circumstances that you will not regard this as an abuse of confidence - we have placed in an envelope and assigned to you, to partly indemnify you against loss by endorsing the \$5000 note at 60% notes, as follows.
