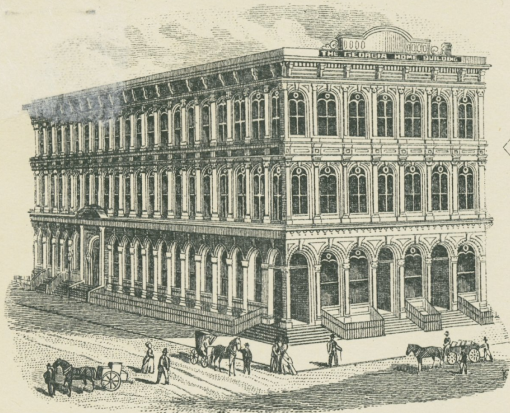

My dear Sir

Some days since Mr. J. C. McGraw, wrote me a note, asking if I did not remember having call^d. upon him. (I think his note said in 1876) for an assessment on stock subscribed by you to the Warrenton Rail Road, & that he had paid that assessment to me for you.

My reply (on the same sheet of paper he had written to me) was that I remembered having call^d. upon him for a certain part of the stock subscribed by you, & that he had paid the same to me. Since thinking more of the matter, I do not feel so positive about it. I do distinctly remember calling on him for a percentage on stock subscribed by some parties, which was p^d. by him to me. but whether it was on your stock or others I cannot just now be very positive. I call^d. on Mr McGraw

two days ago. & told him in substance what
I have here written. he, I suppose has written
you as to what I had written him. if he has
not written you again. stating my recollection
is not clear. in your case. I think it proper
I should do so my self.
