Dear Sir: Your valued favor of 10 inst is before us. As our acct. has been closed since Sept 22 and we distinctly stated in our letter applying for accommodation that we wished the notes discounted to be renewed, it is manifestly unjust to demand payment at maturity without notice. Moreover we have asked for only \$10,000 of the \$15,000 apud upon. We had presumed to think that we had kept a fair average balance while we can strictly conform to your wish in this instance. Your action might have placed us in an embarrassing position -
