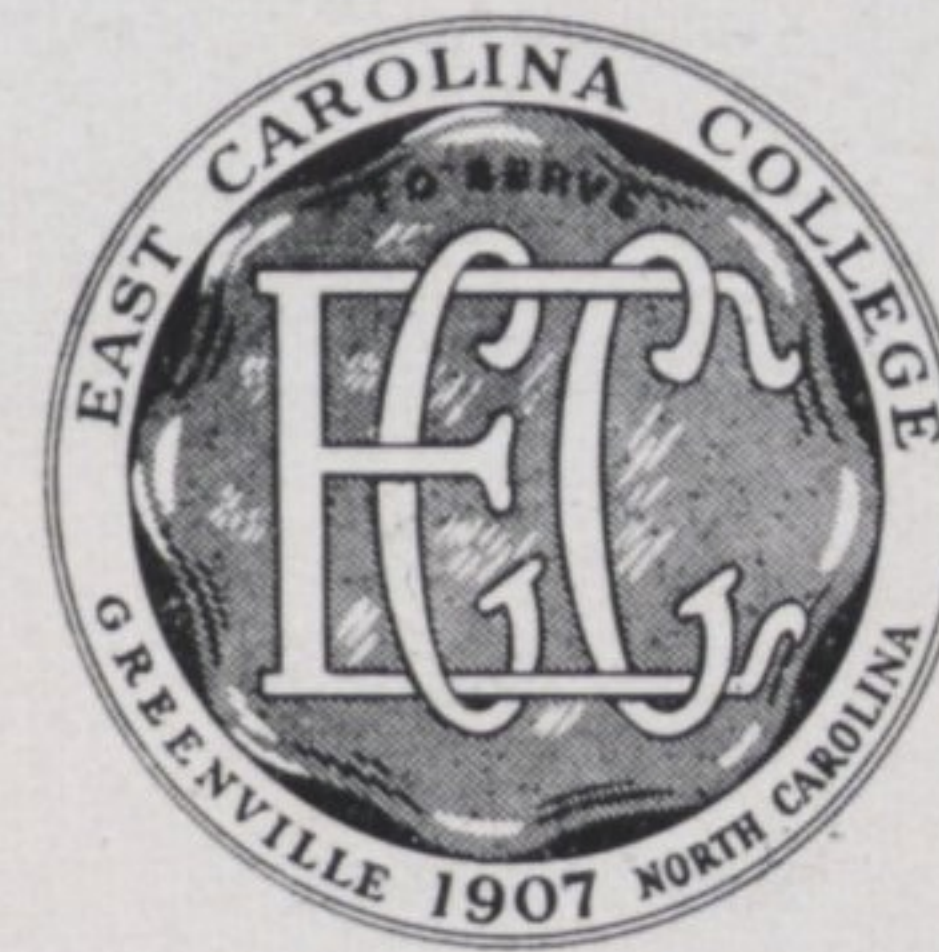

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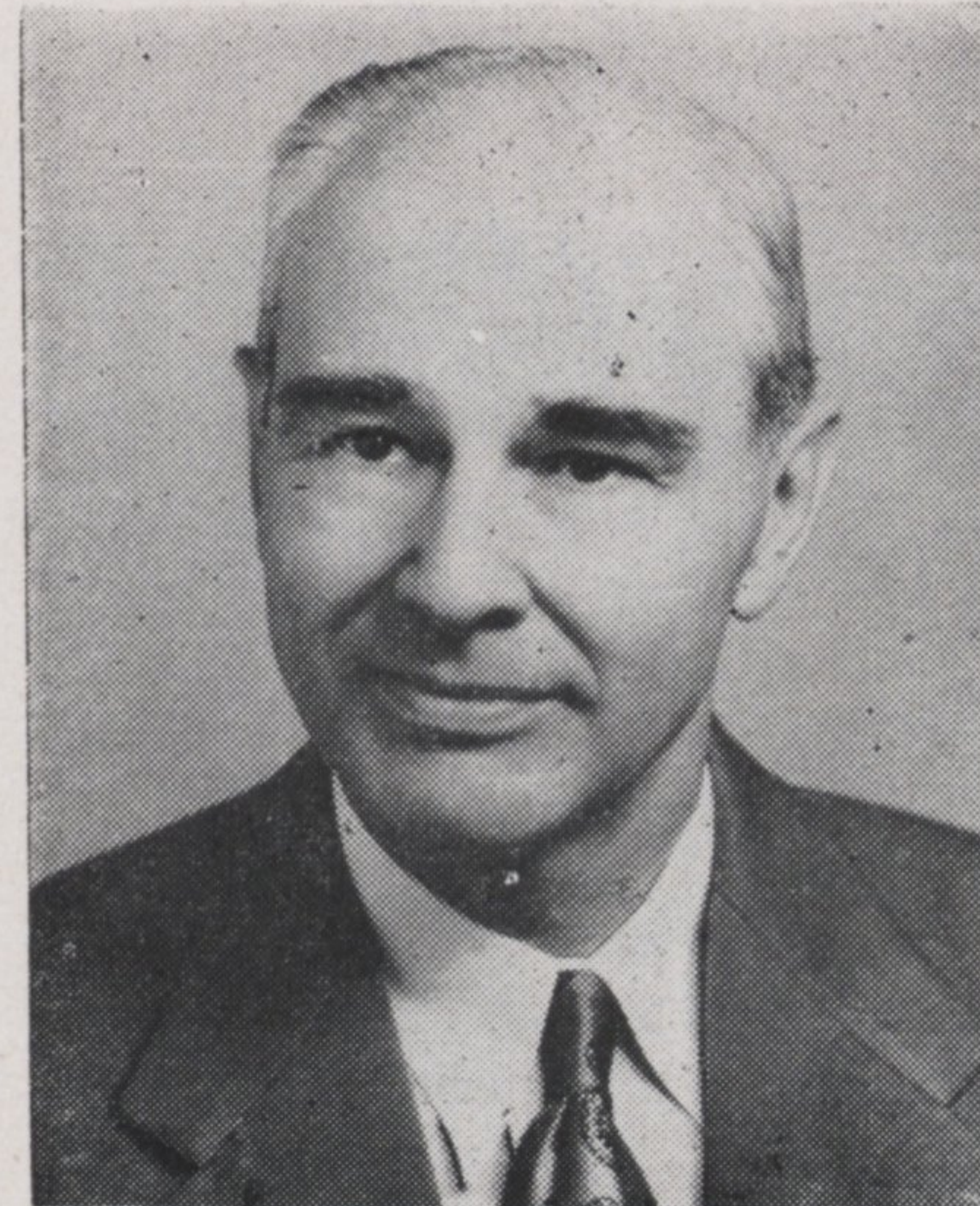
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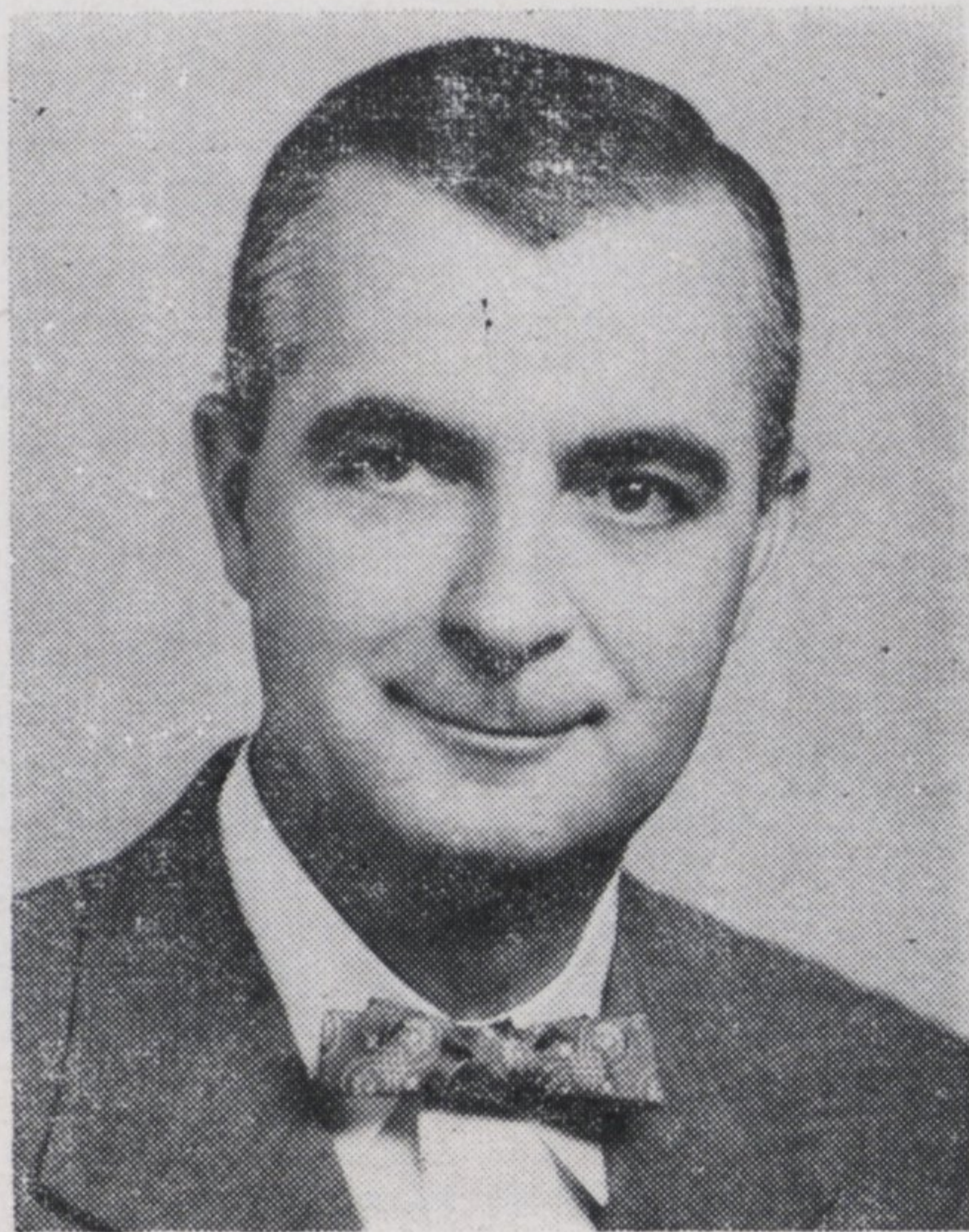
Dean Ruth White, Advisor

If your scholastic record begins to fall below standard we will contact you and offer our help. If you maintain a fine scholarship record we shall be proud. "Well done!"

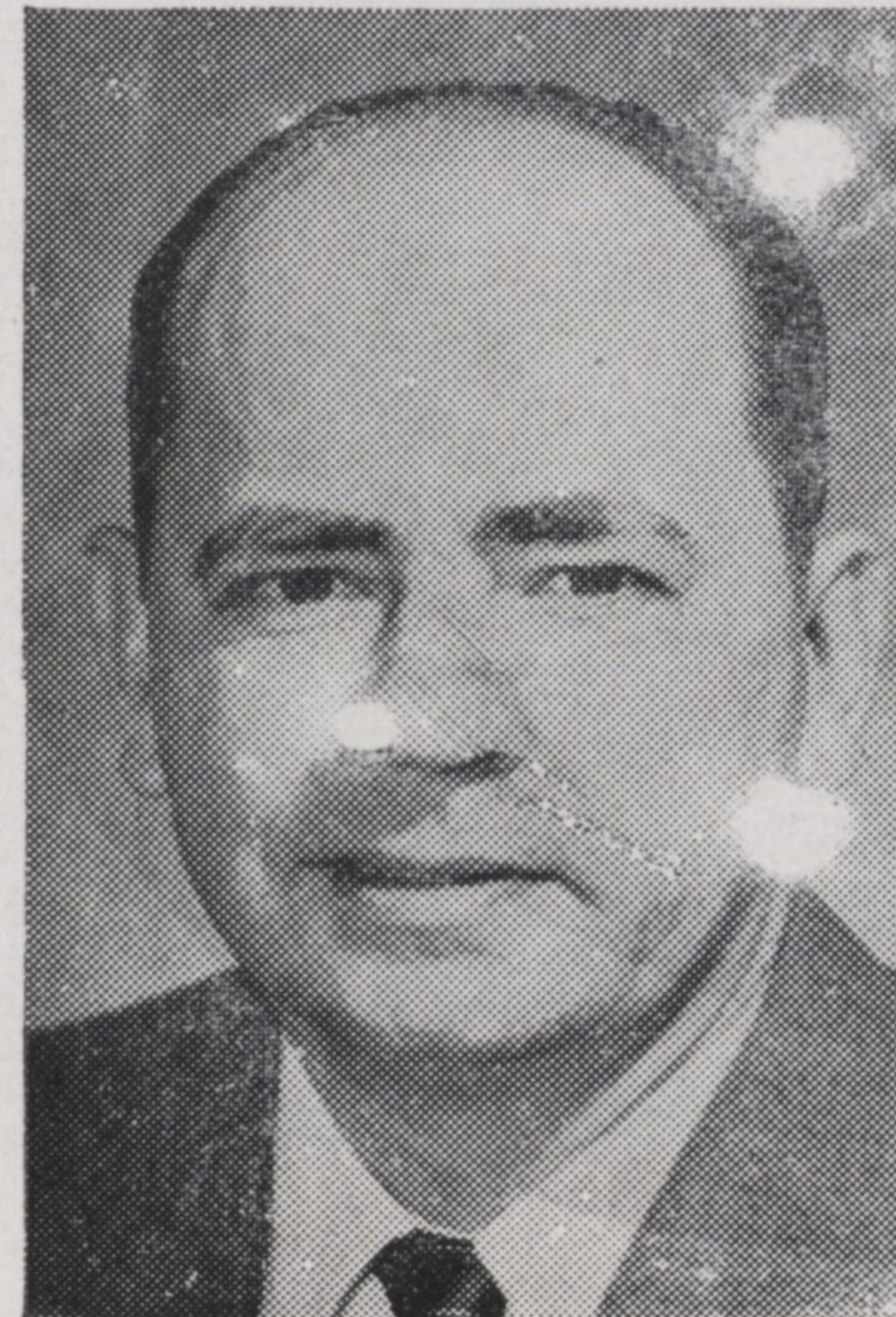

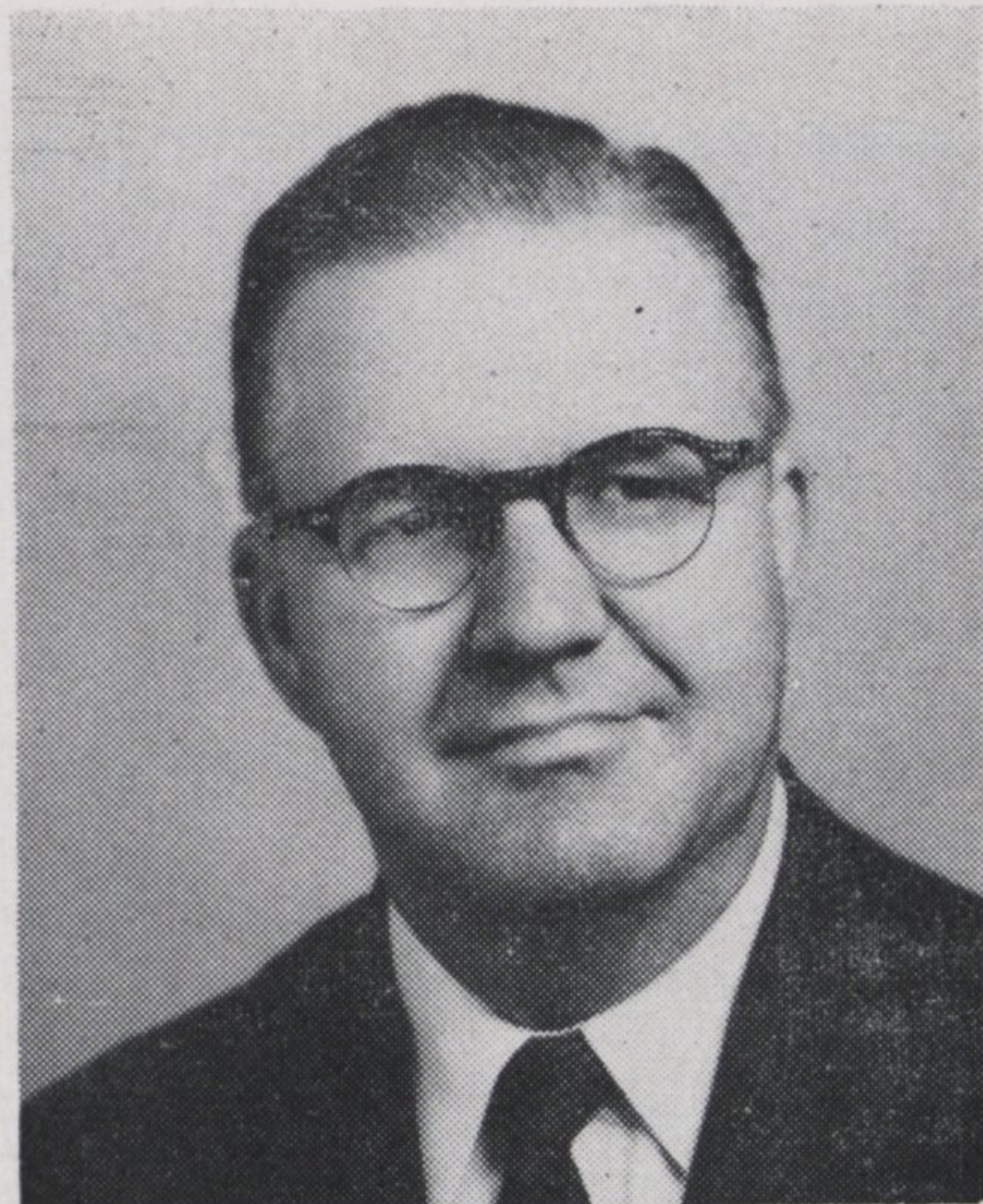

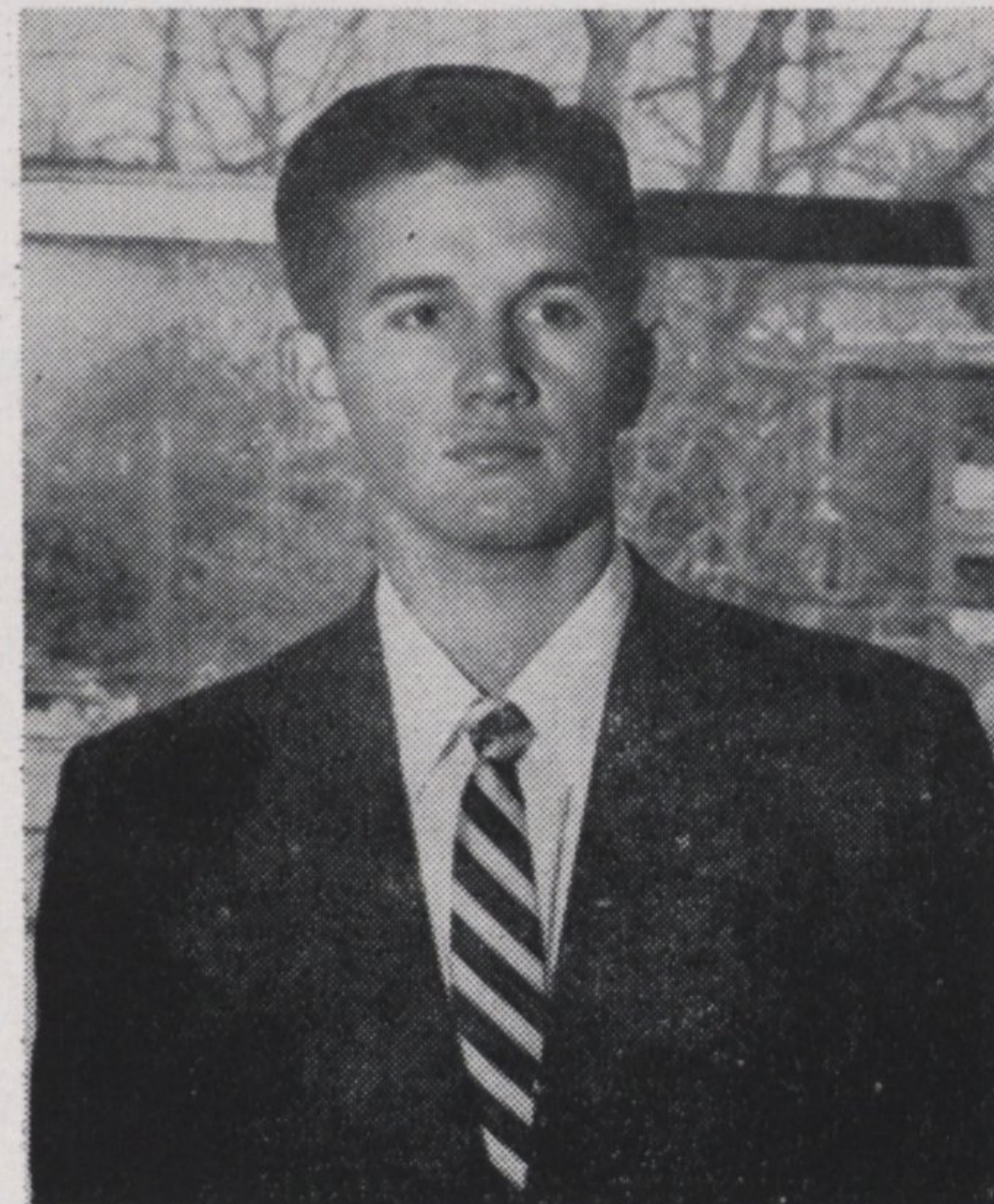
We welcome the new students and transfer students to East Carolina College campus and the ever-growing family of this college.
