Dear Sir

This town of South Mills is an incorporated town of about 400 inhabitants. The town has no officers having failed to elect any at last election. Myself and Dr John A Pod of this place are two of the Charter Members of the South Mills Farmers Alliance No 1213, organized by Dr Sewell last Oct. when approached to join both of us said that we considered ourselves ineligible. Dr Sewell said not. Dr Pod is not a farmer but gets the most of his practice from the Country. I am not a Farmer but a Engineer and Mechanic. I am Engineer and Manager of the Mill and Grader and Cotton buyer

for the man whose name is at the head
of this sheet, now we wish to know whether
either of us has any right in the Alliance. I am
a friend of the Farmers Alliance and am with
them in their fight against the Trusts. but my
conscience is not clear that I have a right to
be a member of an Alliance I own no interest
in this or any other Manufacturing Mill
or Concern. Will you please let me know
what to do, and whether or no I have
any right in an Alliance, and early answer
is desired as our Alliance meets in 10 days
and I am now its President.
