in Oct 15. 450 yds. Nov. 5. 689. On Oct 29
I wrote & cancelled our contract.

They had only furnished about 1/3 as much
they agreed to. & when we were in want
of it could not get it. Now, after
I write to cancel, they report as the
product of the mill.

You see that after I wrote
on 29th Oct. they report nearly
1/2 as much made, ^{as sold} as during the entire season
we only got 3100 yds. Mr Morehead told me
at the State Fair that he would stop at
that time, giving him two weeks notice.

He gives us 30,000 yds in Sept & Oct.
