Resolved: That it behooves all tobacco farmers in the yellow belt to consider the situation seriously and resolve at once to apply a remedy. To this end we recommend and request Bro Elias Carr, President of State Alliance to call a meeting of tobacco farmers in the tobacco belt of NC on Saturday or night during the fair at Raleigh, with a view of arriving at some systematic plan of reducing the average for 1891.
