Now was the action of the meeting at St. Louis final regarding this article or is it to be acted on by the sub-alliances or the County Alliance or State Alliance or all of them as was authorized at our last quarterly

The clause to which I referred
as likely to be objectionable to some
is the second act. We demand
equal rights &c. This is but a re-
statement of the fundamental
principle under lying our Gov-
ernment in its original purity
"of the people, for the people, by
the people". Should we also ^{vote on} discuss
the sub-Treas. Bill. Allow me
to say in my judgement it is di-
rectly opposed to the very act in
our Constitution. Shall we also
vote on the agreement entered in-
to with the Knights of Labor or
was the action final.

Please answer as prompt
as possible. I desire your views to
