This Indenture made and entered into this seventeenth day of April one thousand eight hundred and thirty eight between Elisha Nicles and his wife Nancy of the one part and Spie Wetherington of the other part all of the County of Pitt and State of North Carolina witnesseth that I the said Elisha Nicles and my wife Nancy do for an consideration of the sum of one hundred and thirty five dollars to us in hand paid by Spie Wetherington the receipt is here by acknowledged and we there with fully satisfied contented and paid for a certain place or parcel of land lying and being in the County and State above said adjoining the lands of Brinckley White Elizabeth Wetheringtons Spie Wethering and others and is bounded as follows beginning at a large Short spruce in the Hencob swamp Ambrose Wetherington corner thence running along of marked trees nearly East an hundred and fifty three pole to a pine Said Wetheringtons corner thence South Sixty East twenty one pole to a Stake in a small drain that makes out of the west pacoson thence along the run and winding of the same to a small black gum in said branch thence North Sixty degrees west to a small Sweet gum in hencob swamp thence with the same our corner of the same to the beginning containing Eighty two acres be the same more or less with all Rights titles franchises and immunities thereto belonging and of the said Elisha Nicles and my wife Nancy doth for our selves our heirs Executors and administrators and assigns want and for ever defend the said bargained premises unto the said Spie Wetherington to him his heirs Executors and administrators and assigns for ever and clearly from the lawful claim or claims of all and every person what soever to have and to hold the said bargained premises unto the said Spie Wetherington his Heirs and assigns for ever in witness whereof we have here unto set our hands and fixed our seals this day and date a bove written signed Sealed and delivered in presence of us
