This Indenture made and entered into this seventeenth day of April one
Thousand Eight hundred and thirty Eight between Elisha Niles
and his wife Nancy of the one part and Spire Wetherington of
the other part all of the County of Pitt and State of North
Carolina witnesseth that I the said Elisha Niles and my wife
Nancy do for an in consideration of the sum of one hundred and thirty
five dollars to us in hand paid by Spire Wetherington the Receipt
is hereby acknowledged and we there with fully satisfied conten-
ted and paid for a certain piece or parcel of land lying and
being in the County and State a fore said adjoining the lands
of Brinckley White Elizabeth Wetherington Spire Wetherington
and others and is bounded as follows beginning at a large short stave
pine in the Bonecok Swamp Ambrose Wetherington Corner thence
Running a line of marked trees nearly East one hundred and fifty three
pole to a pine said Wetheringtons Corner thence South sixty East
twenty one pole to a stake in a small chain that makes out of the
west facison thence along the Run and winding of the same
to a small black gum in said branch thence North sixty degrees
west to a small Sweet gum in Bonecok Swamp thence with the Nar-
row Coves of the same to the beginning containing Eighty two
acres be the same more or less with all Rights titles priviledges
and Commodities thereunto belonging and I the said Elisha
Niles and my wife Nancy doth for our selves our heirs Executors
and administrators and assigns warrant and for Ever defend
the said bargained premises unto the said Spire Wetherington
to him his heirs Executors and administrators and assigns for Ever
freely and Clearly from the lawful Claim or Claims of all
and Every person what soever to have and to hold the said bargained
premises unto the said Spire Wetherington his Heirs and assigns
for Ever in witness hereof we have here unto set our hands
and fixed our seals this day and date a bove written signed
