What size silo would be best for me to build? I have some 25 head of cattle & 20 mules to feed would want to feed all of them some ensilage & cows mostly on it, would feed

mules mostly on cover
hay. If ensilage is weighted
down should the board cover
the air tight or nearly so?

once & will be thankful
if you will write me fully
on the subject, at your earliest
convenience, am a beginner
in forming & anxious to learn
how and carefully every ar-
ticle on silos have ever seen
but have gained no prac-
tical information except from
you.
