My dear Colonel:-

I wrote you quite at length some weeks back relative to getting your help towards increasing the efficiency of the Experiment Station by cooperating with the various Alliances throughout the State. I know you must have been busy and have not had time to answer the above letter.

I am very anxious to communicate again with the Secretaries of the County Alliances (for my last letter was received too late) so that each can get his County Alliance to appoint an "Experimental Committee" to take charge of all matters connected with experimental and improved agriculture. Also that the County Alliances recommend each sub-Alliance in the County appoint a similar committee for the same purpose. And that each committee as formed to report to me so that I can aid them in conducting further operations and to help them with all the force of the Station.

If you think well of the plan and can write me a strong official letter as President of the Alliance I can send this out in time to be considered at the coming January meeting of the County Alliances.

I have no doubt the same will result in very great material good.
