At Wake Forest

College, there is two or three of the Professors who are members of the Alliance, or have been, and as there is some talk of their wanting to join our Lodge, I write to ask your ruling in regard to their eligibility. Is a Professor or President of a College, who are farmers also, eligible to membership? Is a Student of Wake Forest College, who was a member of the Alliance before coming to college, eligible, or any who have never belonged

to the Alliance eligible? Have we the right to appoint a merchant as our business Agent, & then admit him as a member of our Lodge?

We have moved our Alliance from Forestville to Wake Forest and Professor Carlile & others at that place are strong Alliance men & will make an effort to come in, & I understand there are 30 or more of the Students who are members, will probably make an effort to come in. If any of these come with demits from their Lodge and you rule them ineligible, what must we do?
