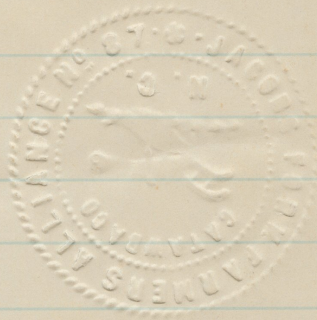

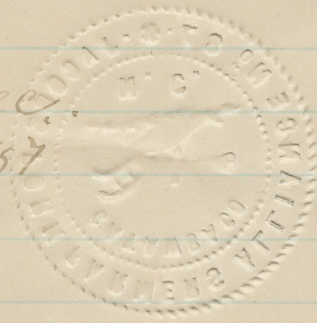
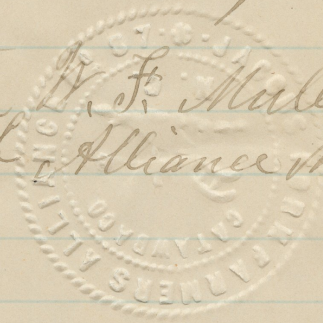
Dr Brother
