2nd If a member or members call for

Alliance by the name and number that
they give and no Alliance organized
at the place they want Dernits to go to
and the President rule that it is unconsti-
tional to issue those Dernits under the



circumstances and one of said members demand Demits the second time then and there without debate, and the President refuse to grant those demits the second time, what action should the Alliance take in regard to this matter

3rd If a member of an Alliance who has a fair education was to go in to any measure that would expell him or her from the Alliance and lead others of limited education in to the same measures would they all have to be expelled
