1st When a member of
a subordinate Alliance,
abuses another subordinate
Alliance, in open Alliance
and makes application
for a Demit, should he
be Expelled without trial,
^{or} according to Article 9 Sec 2
of the State Constitution.

2nd Has the County Alliance
the power to receive
an appeal from a member
who has been Expelled
over

from a subordinate Alliance
under Article 9, Sec. 2,
of State Constitution.

"Said member could not
be recommended as a worthy
member, to other Alliances
be cause, he did not act
Constitutionally in other cases."
"He brought unconstitutional
questions before the Alliance
and asked that they be acted
on without debate or amendment
and when the Brethren tried,
to reason with him, he used
insulting language to some
of the Brethren, in open
Alliance, therefore we could
not issue him a Demit with
a clear conscience.
