My dear Sir.

I beg to call your attention to the report of the Proceedings of the State N.C. Industrial & Development Assn. that convened in Raleigh on the 13<sup>th</sup> & 14<sup>th</sup> insts; as published in the Chronicle & News & Observer papers of those respective dates. I sincerely trust that you will accept the position of Vice President of said Association. Permit me to call your attention to the Resolution adopted requesting, "if agreeable to you," your active assistance in the furtherance of said movement by sending out a communication to your County and Sub Alliances asking them to give their aid to the County-Commissioners in furthering the aims indicated in the resolutions."

As the time is so close at hand. June 1st prox. for the meetings of said Boards. I can't have

a meeting of the Executive Com. but I shall be  
in Raleigh on Monday night or early Tuesday  
and will be happy if you can meet me there  
and if not, if you will be so kind as to ad-  
dress me there to the care of the Southern  
Immigration Bureau - My idea is to  
get the Governor to issue his proclamation,  
as provided in said resolutions, in time  
for distribution before Monday the 1st June,  
and if you have the time will be very much  
obliged if you will suggest any names  
to be inserted in said proclamation as  
provided in the 5<sup>th</sup> Resolution -
