The difficulty with the brewer bosses is caused by their denying us the right to organize. Blacklisting and other wise mistreatment those who they sus- spect of having joined a labor organization although they themselves claim the right to organize to rob their employees & the public.

These beer barons backed by the millions of dollars they have wrong from the laborers, think themselves strong enough to resist any attempt on the part of the working men to uphold his rights.
