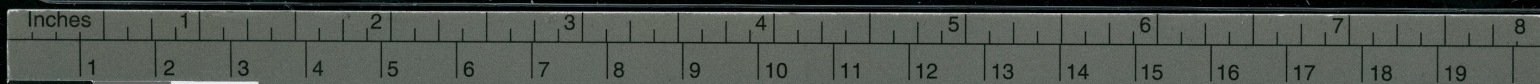
To the Pres of N.C. F. A.
