I find that all level headed Alliance men hereabouts are greatly interested to carry the State ticket and keep our Republican rule

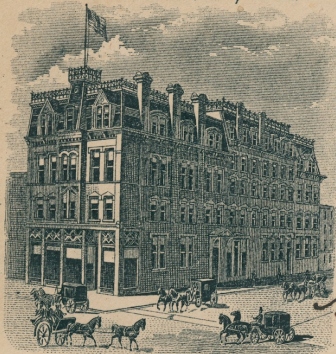
The address of Col A. S. Forsman is
