I went out to Mr

debt good beyond a reasonable
doubt, Cost of Recording the
Spring Return deed and

Deakes bill \$1. and my charge
for drawing deed and
Mortgage. Use of house and
barn & 1/2 acre land will
be \$15. Which I hope will
be satisfactory. Enclosed

trust will be forwarded
as soon as received.

entirely satisfactory.
