Dear Sir: - Yours of 24th inst, rec^d
in which you inform us that
you have notified Mrs Rethel L.
Overby, Macon, N.C. (the maker of
note transferred us as Collateral
Security), that one of her notes, dated
Mch 28th 1893, & carrying interest at 8%
from date, for \$150⁰⁰, & payable to
your order, will be due Dec 1st /94.

You instruct us to draw on
her, through Messrs Gardner & Jefferys,
Warrenton, N.C. if not paid us
by her on Dec 1st /94. - and we,
accordingly, wrote her that if
not paid us at maturity, we
would draw on her at sight.
