Dear Father,

I have thought it strange that so many silver men were defeated last month, despite the evident rapid growth of the silver sentiment in this country. It really worried me to acct. for it, & I determined about 2 weeks <sup>ago</sup> to get some figures on the subject. Now the most cursory analysis of the returns shows that in nearly <sup>every</sup> instance the silver vote was largely increased. Take Bland for instance, His case is like those of many of the defeated ones, In -92. Bland recd. 18927 votes, Murphy, Rep. 16453 & the Pop. candidate 104. In -94 Bland



and 16815, His Rep. opponent 16885  
& the Pop. 3528, Island being beaten  
by but 70 votes, yet you see his  
district is represented by a good  
maniac, though the majority of its  
voters advocate silver, this as I have  
said is the case with many of  
the defeated silver candidates.

I have just heard that the Fat  
car line drivers & conductors have  
shut because of a heavy reduction  
in wages, & that there is great  
excitement on the st. I must go  
out to see the trouble, & continue  
this letter some other time.

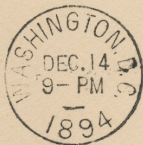
