Dear Sir

I will this morning

to him ever living in this place
any more besides he cant make
a living. I want him to go work
and pay his debt. for he hasnt
been able to make ay thing for
last three years. he has gave

but one dollar ^{that} from Col person
I have no idie what he intend
doing but hope you will advise

him to leave Sparta ^{and} never let
him know I wrote you because
it would make him mad with
me. and think He would come
nearer taking your advise than
