water for Braunbridge for 1895
has about given out.

I will send statement of acct
of 1894 as soon as I can get it
ready. I am in hope that
the increase of stuff on hand over
that of Jan 1894 with proper rotation
will make the crop for out about even.

The milk for 1894 was 73148
" Butter " " " 30504³

Thus requiring without deduction of
milk & cream used for other purposes
24th milk to make 1st Butter, which
is a better showing than was made at the test
during the World's Fair. Am glad to hear Eleanor is better
Love to all your affec^{ed} (over) Eliza

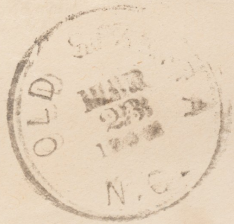
