I have been considering the advisability of filing a supplemental answer presenting this point; to wit. Under the Constitution the power to amend or repeal all charters granted since its adop-

tion is reserved to the Legislature: the N. E.
R. R. Co. has accepted amendments to its
charter since 1868; then the charter is
amended becomes subject to the reserved
power to amend. Judge Allen did not pre-
