My Dear Governor:

I try to express my sympathy for you in the loss of your cotton. I don't know much about it, and hope it is not so bad as I have heard.

I have just returned from the Roanoke, and found our affairs in pretty good shape. About 2/3 of the cotton & some corn gathered. One half of our wheat sowed & up. I think we will get about 1800 or 1900 Bbls, practically same number of Bbls we made last year.

I recd. yours in regard to Maj. Guthrie's matter met him this P.M. and will confer further with his Superintendent.
