C., June 24th.—All last night and this morning delegates and visitors kept pouring into Charlotte, and though the streets it had almost the appearance of a town run over with folks, no one was heard to complain that Charlotte was not taking care of them all right. Some visitors were so enthusiastic that they seemed not to sleep at all, but throughout the night the streets resounded with cries of "Kitchin," "Craig," "Horne." Everything was good humored.

RESOLUTIONS BY PHYSICIANS

Relating to the Prescribing of Intoxicating Liquors in North Carolina.

Dr. Way vacated the president's chair and on behalf of himself and Dr. Laughinghouse introduced them and moved their adoption:

Whereas, the people of the State of North Carolina have by a large majority vote recently ratified an act which after January 1st, 1909, makes illegal the sale of intoxicating liquors in North Carolina except upon physician's prescriptions.

Whereas, the legislature of North Carolina, in amending the prohibition law, did evidence great confidence in the medical profession of said state by placing in the hands of such profession to an extent the success or failure of the law, in that the members of the said medical profession are given the right to prescribe spirituous liquors at their discretion.

Resolved: 1st. That the Medical Society of the State of North Carolina in fifty fifth regular annual session assembled to hereby condemn as unprofessional and disgraceful conduct in its members in the exercise of the privileges conferred in this law.

2nd. That the Medical Society of the State of North Carolina respectfully urges upon all the physicians of this state, who are members of this society or not, to join in demonstrating to the people that the members of the medical profession can be relied upon implicitly to perform their full duty in aiding in the enforcement of the prohibition law and in building up a public sentiment that will insure protection against an illegal traffic in intoxicating liquors.

3d. That the Medical Society of the State of North Carolina respectfully urges upon the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina the manifest duty of revoking the license to practice of any physician who may be proven guilty of abusing the privilege accorded him in the prescribing of intoxicants.

J. Howell Way, President. Chas. J. O'H. Laughinghouse, Secretary. Unanimously adopted by vote of the Society and ordered given to the press of the state for publication.

Y. A. Stenton, Sec'y. J. Howell Way, President. The above resolutions showing a fine purpose on the part of the physicians of the State to make the prohibition law effective.

They are to be commended and should have the support of all good citizens in this effort to carry out the will of the people. If the third resolution is enforced the unworthy man making himself a disgrace to an honorable profession will after a time be put out of business. Well done for the doctors of North Carolina.
