Dr. Parkhurst, the great New York preacher who recently made a trip South and spent some days in North Carolina, talked to his congregation last Sunday about the negro North and South. Here is his version of the difference: "The Southern white man dislikes the negro, and owns up to it, while the white man in the North dislikes the negro, and lies about it." The Doctor seems to have seen enough of the situation to know what he is talking about.

Dr. Parkhurst closed by the following general reference to present condition among Southern people:

"The South does not altogether love us, but no one there hates us nearly as it would be perfectly natural for them to hate us. They are all glad that slavery is done. They are all glad that they are in the Union. They all glory in the flag, even while in tender bereavement they lay flowers upon the graves of the Confederate dead. We belong to them and they belong to us, and every deed of kindness they have rendered, every word of sympathetic interest, every relation and every interchange of hospitality discreetly arranged will be so much contribution to that perfect readjustment of relations which shall make for the enrichment of our common history."

ANOTHER PROBLEM.

Can Brick be Laid up a Hill?

The Greenville Aldermen don't lose any more sleep over knotty problems. If one arises they just take right hold and pull the knicks out of it. They got over that Fifth street house building question all right, so concluded that nothing else will be too hard for them.

His nerves had almost given away, and he was scarcely responsible for his actions.—Kinston Free Press.

WASHINGTON LETTER.

From Our Regular Correspondent.

WASHINGTON, D. C., April 29.

Senator Cockrell stated the case in a nutshell when he said, the other day that the Cuban mission deserved their status. This has become plain since the committee from the Cuban Constitutional Convention reached Washington. Although they represent no government and are paid salaries by the United States they came to Washington with the idea that their one government to negotiate with another, and they have been greatly surprised to discover that they were in Washington to be sold and entertained at White House State dinners and such functions, but not to negotiate. A negotiator must necessarily have credentials, and where, pray, would these Cubans get credentials? The convention which elected them has no government behind it, except the military government of the United States, and a government cannot negotiate with itself. The subject upon which these self-declared Cubans were most anxious to negotiate was the tariff—they wish this government to lower or entirely remove the duty on Cuban sugar and tobacco, and having ascertained that Congress alone could act, they have been trying to get what chance there was of securing Mr. McKinley's promise to recommend such legislation to Congress. They have not received any encouragement in that line, nor in the hope that Congress would modify the conditions said down by the Platt amendment.

The charge of the Light Brigade was not in it with the onslaught made upon Mr. McKinley this week by republican Senators and Representatives to secure some of the army commission pie before it was all gone—the names of nearly 500 appointments to be lieutenants made public this week. They made things so warm for Mr. McKinley that he had to do something to save them off, and about all the places he was promised some of them to the constituents of the very men who were clamoring for more to be told them that many of those appointed would probably fail to pass the examination necessary to get a commission and that then they would have another chance. Most of them had to be content with that, but it is understood that Senator Quay and Pease, who held up Mr. McKinley together, succeeded in landing another bunch of commissions, in addition to those they had previously received.

The British Ambassador called on Secretary Hay this week in order to find out whether this government had any suggestions to make, previous to its taking the road for six weeks, about renewing negotiations for a treaty dealing with the Isthmian Canal question. Mr. Hay had no suggestion to make, because he has not been able to get sufficient Senatorial support to justify his trying to negotiate another treaty.

When it comes to so working out a problem so that the public is bamboozled and no patronage lost, the average republican politician can easily beat the world. An example has just been made public. It is officially announced that Mr. McKinley and Secretary Root have decided that the number of enlisted men in the regular army shall be limited to 76,000, unless there is a fresh outbreak in the Philippines. This was to bamboozle the public, and will make small difference for a long time as the shrewdness in recruiting made it certain that it would take many months to enlist all the men authorized by the new army law. Accompanying the announcement was the statement that all the officers provided for by law would be appointed. That was to save the patronage over which there has been so much scrambling. If there are more officers than there is work for there are always nice little details, in Washington and elsewhere, to which those with pull enough can be assigned, the principle duties of which are social.

Mr. McKinley's record breaking Presidential free excursion led Washington today on its little jaunt of 10,581 miles. The special train consists of seven Pullman cars, each selected as the most elegant of its kind. The trip will cost thousands of dollars, but it is doubtful whether a cent of it will come out of the pocket of any one of the 38 passengers.

Secretary Cortelyou was thoroughly alive to the advertising possibilities of the trip, when he arranged that more than one fourth of the passengers should be newspaper men, and he took care that there should be artists among them. Also, that a good photographer should be on the train, as well as telegraph operators. There are nine ladies to keep Mrs. McKinley company, and Dr. Risley is on hand to look after their health, and that of the rest of the party. If the movement that has been started in Washington to make the daughters of the American Revolution an auxiliary to the machine that is booming Senator Fairbanks of Indiana, for the republican Presidential nomination in 1904 is successful, the D. A. R. will probably have a split on its hands and will certainly suffer in the esteem of those who are of principle opposed to the participation in partisan politics of such organizations. This movement, which is understood to have been started with the knowledge of Mrs. Fairbanks, President General of the D. A. R., and wife of the Senator, is to have the D. A. R. National Board unofficially request every chapter in the country to use the influence of its members with fathers, sons, husbands and friends, to secure support for the Fairbanks' boom. It is believed they wish to keep the movement secret that the National Board of the D. A. R. recently decided that the press should be rigidly excluded, not only from the Board meetings, but from future National Congresses of the organization. That decision provoked such adverse criticism that the Board has since announced that it had been temporarily abandoned. It has from its organization been plain that the D. A. R. had nothing to do with the political movement, but the same claim has been made for organizations of men, which are constantly dabbling in partisan ship.

Nothing but praise is heard of the action of Mr. McKinley, taken in response to a written request of Senator Daniel, of Virginia, in ordering that the Washington relics, which have for some years been on exhibition in the National Museum, be restored to their proper owner, Gen. G. W. C. Lee, of Virginia, a son of Gen. R. E. Lee, from whose home, at Arlington, the relics were taken at the opening of the Civil War. While it was action that should have voluntarily been taken years ago, by some president, Mr. McKinley is entitled to credit for taking it even at this late day, and to more credit for the manly letter to Senator Daniel, in which he announced his intention to do so.

All the administration will be used to get Minister E. H. Conger, nominated for Governor by the Iowa republicans. Not because it loves Conger over well or desires to see him honored, but because it doesn't wish him to return to China as U. S. Minister, nor to tell him that he cannot. In other words, for purely selfish reasons, the administration wishes Mr. Conger nominated for governor of Iowa. He displeased the administration several times during the negotiations in Pekin, and he has displeased it again by his published interviews since he reached the U. S., but his standing as a powerful missionary element in this country is such that the administration is afraid to kick him out of the diplomatic service.

An Oklahoma postmaster who wanted to go "hot" hunting notified the Department that the office would be "shot" for several days. They might "fire" him if they wanted to, but he gave them a "pinter"—that he was the only man around there that could "ride or rite."—Wilmington Star.

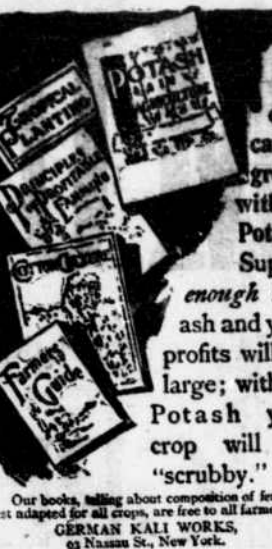
