Perhaps the greatest strike ever inaugurated in this country was that which started Monday among the machinists. Thirteen States are involved and 50,000 workmen walked out of the shops at a given time. The machinists are demanding a nine-hour work day with a ten-hour scale of wages. In many of the large cities their demand has been conceded. Most of the factories have large orders ahead, and to quit work now would mean great loss as well as serious hindrance to enterprises all over the country.

Greenville's public spiritedness is to be commended. The town voting for an issue of \$75,000 bonds for public improvements, and voting for the establishment of a graded school, shows our people have grown tired of moving along behind the times and have determined to be progressive. It is now the duty of all to work together in harmony so that the results may arise from this new life we are taking on. There is a bright future for Greenville if advantage is taken of the many opportunities in reach. Let differences be put aside and all work together for the advancement of the town.

Tomorrow will decide the graded school question for Greenville, as the bill passed by the recent Legislature will then be voted upon. There are some objections raised to the bill, but these are not, or should not be, material and the bill should be ratified at the polls. If the matter is defeated now it will mean a delay of two years before any other steps can be taken to get a graded school, and one defeat would make the second easier. The Board of Education has the present bill should be carried, then it would be much easier to make any desired amendments when another legislative meets than it would be to have to go all over the whole matter again of getting another bill passed and holding another election. Defeat the matter and we believe Greenville prospects for getting a graded school are killed for a long time to come, and this will be a reflection on the town that our people can not afford. Vote for the school.

Governor C. B. Aycock made a great speech in New York, Monday night, at a dinner given by the North Carolina Society in that city. Judge Augustus Van Wyck, president of the society, was toast master. Our Governor, already famous for his oratory and fine speeches, never acquitted himself better than on this occasion. The speech was one that should make every North Carolinian feel proud of her Governor.
